HOUSE BILL NO. 3231

Introduced by HONORABLE CARLO OLIVER D. DIASNES

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill seeks the establishment of a Congressional District Skills Training Center for Out-of-School Youth in the island-municipality of Sabtang in the province of Batanes.

The Constitution provides that the state recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, intellectual and social well-being. It shall also inculcate in the youth patriotism and nationalism and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs.

This policy acknowledges the vital role of the youth in nation-building and its acceptance of their involvement in matters affecting the national welfare. The recognition of the potentials of the youth and their new social consciousness to get involved in the affairs of the nation impels the state to promote the physical and intellectual well-being of the youth. This can be effected by having a nationwide campaign for their physical and intellectual development.

The setting up of the center will spur economic development as it will help solve the problem of unemployment in the island- municipality of Sabtang and the province of Batanes as a whole. Enhancing the capabilities of the youth will make them more productive and transform them into useful and dynamic citizens.

In view of the foregoing, passage of this bill is earnestly sought.

AN ACT
ESTABLISHING A DISTRICT SKILLS TRAINING CENTER FOR THE OUT-OF-SCHOOL YOUTH IN THE ISLAND- MUNICIPALITY OF SABTANG IN THE PROVINCE BATANES AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. A District Skills and Training Center for Out-of-School Youth is hereby established in the island-municipality of Sabtang in the province of Batanes.

SECTION 2. The center shall be established under the supervision of the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority.

SECTION 3. The Technical Education and Skills Development Authority shall issue the necessary implementing rules, policies, regulations and guidelines for the speedy and effective implementation of this Act.

SECTION 4. The amount necessary for the implementation of this Act shall be charged to the appropriations of the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority under the General Appropriations Act, in the year following its enactment. Thereafter, the funds necessary for its continued implementation shall be included in the Annual General Appropriations Act.

This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
