RESOLUTION URGING THE CONGRESS OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES TO PROMOTE AND ADOPT THE PRINCIPLES AND OBJECTIVES OF THE INTERNATIONAL LABOR ORGANIZATION DECLARATION ON SOCIAL JUSTICE FOR A FAIR GLOBALIZATION ADOPTED BY THE INTERNATIONAL LABOR CONFERENCE ON JUNE 10, 2008

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2008, the International Labour Conference has adopted at its 97th Session in Geneva, Switzerland the International Labor Organization (ILO) Declaration on Social Justice for a Fair Globalization ;


WHEREAS, the Department of Labor and Employment , through Secretary Marianito D. Roque, has recommended to the Committee on Labor of both chambers of Congress the mobilization of all available means of action to promote the objectives and implement the commitments enshrined in the Declaration;

WHEREAS, our present policies on labor, which are based on social justice, share the same objectives, aspirations and commitments enshrined in the said Declaration;

WHEREAS, there is a need to express the support of Congress to advance the noble cause and intention of the ILO Declaration on Social Justice for a Fair Globalization in the country;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives, in session assembled to promote and adopt the principles and objectives of the International Labor Organization DECLARATION ON SOCIAL JUSTICE FOR A FAIR GLOBALIZATION adopted by the International Labor Conference on June 10,2008.
