**REPORT OF THE
EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING**

His Excellency Jose de Venecia, Jr., President of the 27th AIPO chaired the Executive Committee Meeting held at Marco Polo Cebu Plaza Hotel at 21:15 on September 10, 2006.

APPOINTMENT OF RAPPORTEUR

Honorable Antonio V. Cuenco, Chairman of the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Representatives of the Congress of the Philippines was appointed Rapporteur of the Meeting.

PROGRAM OF ACTIVITIES

The Executive Meeting approved *in toto* the proposed Program of Activities.

Upon the request of the Thai delegation, the speech of Mr. AIPO Professor Dr. Prasop Ratanokorn was allowed to be read during the 1st Plenary Session.

AGENDA ITEMS FOR THE COMMITTEE MEETINGS

The Executive Meeting approved the proposed agenda items of the various Committees including the agenda items of the Women Parliamentarians of AIPO (WAIPO) which already held its meeting earlier that day.

The Thailand delegation was allowed to present its report on the regional Seminar for Parliamentarians from South East Asia and the Asia-Pacific Region on Security Sector Reforms in the National and Regional Contexts.

The Indonesian delegation manifested their desire to present a resolution on the Middle East relative to Lebanon crisis, which request the Executive Meeting approved as an agenda item of the Committee on Political Matters.

The AIPO Ad Hoc committee proposed the consideration of a resolution on Common Legislative Initiatives on Improving the Quality Standard and Quantity of Agriculture Products as an agenda item of the Committee on Economic Matters.

The Ad Hoc committee likewise proposed the inclusion of a draft resolution on Common Legislative Initiatives on Pandemic Diseases as the First Test Case.

The Philippine proposal to include a resolution on the creation of an Anti-Disaster Fund was incorporated under the agenda item of the Committee on Social Matters on Disaster Management and Emergency Response.

PROPOSED TOPICS FOR THE DIALOGUE WITH OBSERVER COUNTRIES

The proposed topics for dialogue with observer countries were approved.
