RESOLUTION
ON
THE AMENDMENTS TO THE STATUTES OF AIPO

The Twenty-Seventh General Assembly:

Recalling the results of Chiang Mai and Bangkok Meetings adopted at the 26th AIPO General Assembly in Vientiane, Lao PDR, in September 2005, which firmly decided to change the Study Committee into the AIPO Ad-Hoc Committee on the Transformation of AIPO into a More Effective and Closely Integrated Institution and mandated the House of Representatives of the Republic of Indonesia to host its First and Second Meetings;

Mindful of Resolution 26GA/2005/Org/05 and Resolution 26GA/2005/Org/06 of the 26th AIPO General Assembly held on 18 – 23 September 2005 in Vientiane, Lao PDR which mandated the House of Representatives of the Republic of Indonesia to host the AIPO Ad-Hoc Committee Meeting on the Transformation of AIPO into a More Effective and Closely Integrated Institution;

Recalling further that one of the tasks of the aforesaid ad-hoc committee is to amend certain fundamental articles of the Statutes of AIPO;

Having considered that AIPO urgently needs to strengthen its structure by more empowering positions of the President, the Executive Committee and Secretary General;

Having considered further the dynamics of regional and international cooperation particularly in respect with ASEAN as well as AIPO and their collective efforts in the attainment of the objectives of the ASEAN Community by 2020;

Taking into consideration that to achieve the goals of transforming AIPO, it deems necessary to amend the Statutes of AIPO (as well as to change the name of the institution);

Noting the possibility to amend the Statutes of AIPO as stipulated in Chapter X, Article 23;

Hereby resolves to consider the attached Statutes as the initial draft and to adopt it provisionally for further consideration at the Extra-Ordinary Executive Committee Meeting to be held in Malaysia in March 2007.
