**RESOLUTION**  
**ON**  
**EXPRESSION OF APPRECIATION OF THE WORK AND LEADERSHIP OF**  
**HIS EXCELLENCY,**  
**THE HONORABLE JOSE DE VENECIA, JR.**  
**THE PRESIDENT OF AIPO**

The Twenty-Seventh General Assembly:

**Noting** that the tenure of His Excellency, Jose de Venecia, Jr. as the President of AIPO will expire at the conclusion of the 27<sup>th</sup> AIPO General Assembly;

**Recognizing** his efficient stewardship of the 27<sup>th</sup> General Assembly and his significant contributions towards making AIPO a full partner of ASEAN and transforming AIPO and ASEAN into popular instruments of the Southeast Asian peoples;

**Acknowledging** that he is the original proponent of the Global Inter-Faith Dialogue that was endorsed by the UN Secretary General Kofi Anan and the G-77 countries; of the 2001 Anti-Terrorist Agreement among the Philippines, Malaysia, Indonesia, Thailand Cambodia and Australia; and of the Debt-For-Equity Proposal to help implement the UN Millenium Development Goals (MDGs) to reduce global poverty by fifty percent (50%) by 2015 which will benefit the 102 most heavily-indebted nations;

**Commending** his major role in Asian political affairs as founder and chairman of the Standing Committee of the International Conference of Asian Political Parties (ICAPP), as Chair of the Senior Advisory Council of the Asia-wide Association of Asian Parliaments for Peace (AAPP) and as Co-Chair, with Philippine President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo of the Philippine delegation to the Non-Aligned Movement (NAM) Leaders' Summit in Havana, Cuba on September 15-16, 2006;

**Expresses** its deep appreciation for his work for and leadership of the ASEAN Inter-Parliamentary Organization (AIPO) and wishes him all the best in his future endeavors.
