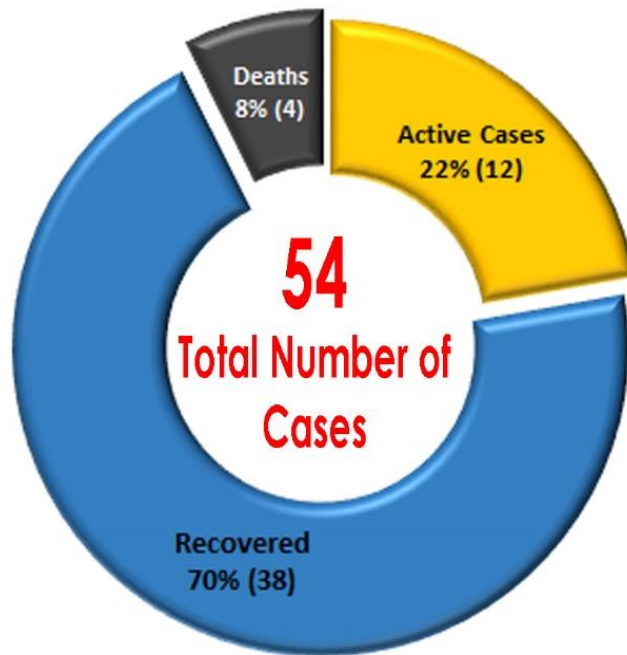




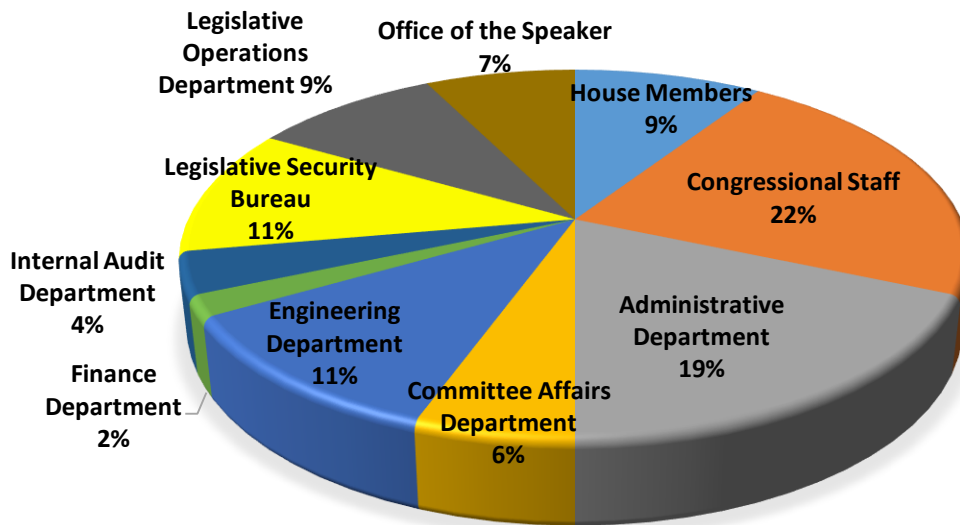

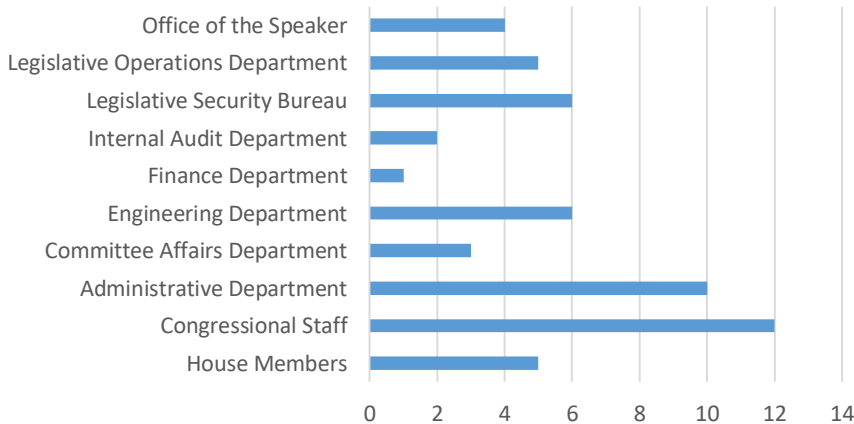


Eleven active cases manifested mild symptoms while one manifested moderate symptoms.

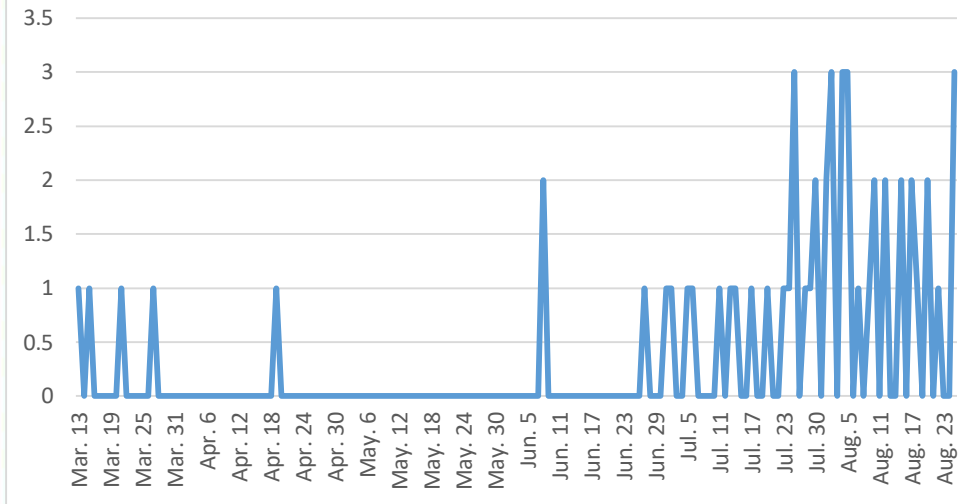

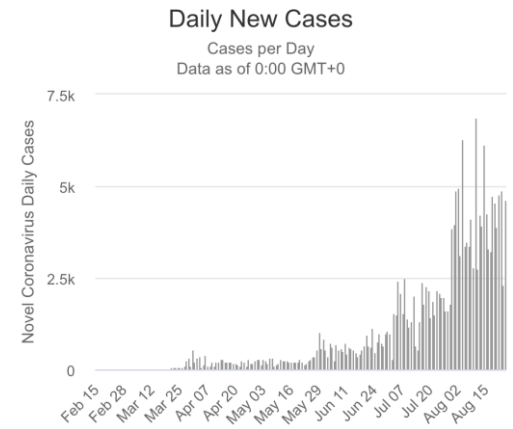

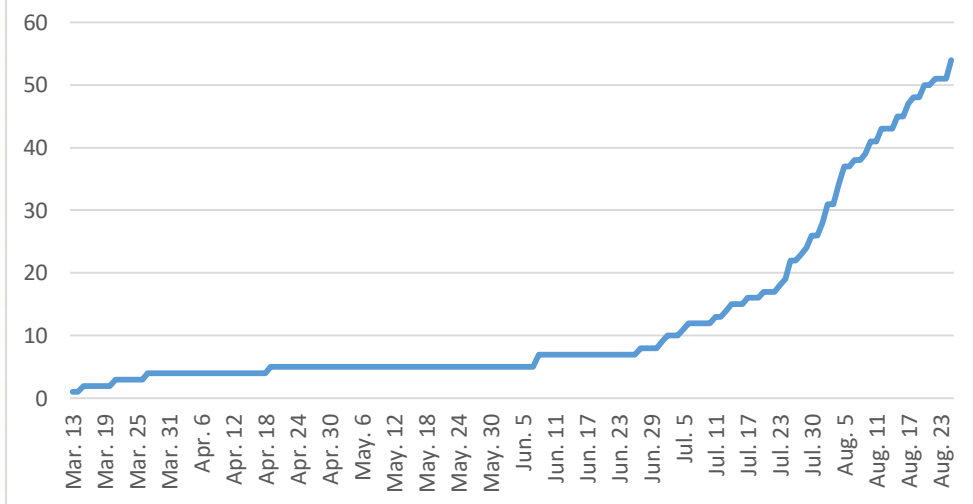
Daily New Cases in HRep



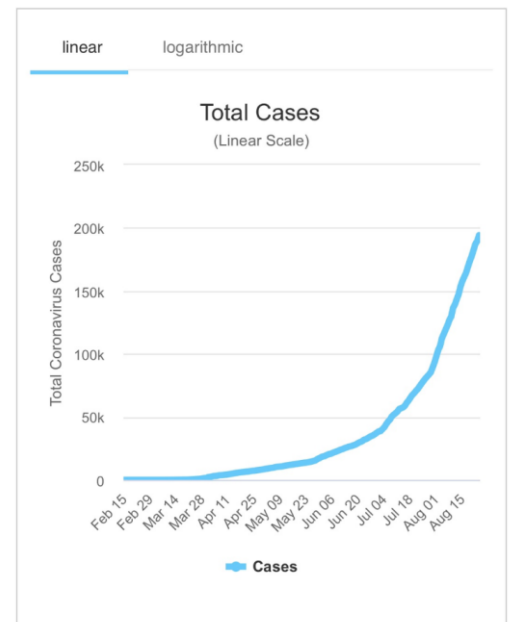
Daily New Cases in the Philippines



Total Cases in HRep (Linear Scale)



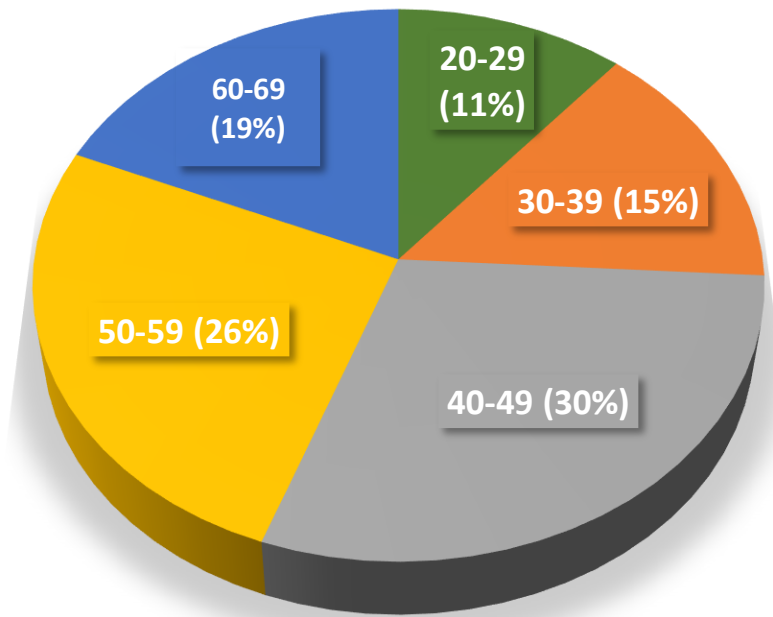
Total Coronavirus Cases in the Philippines



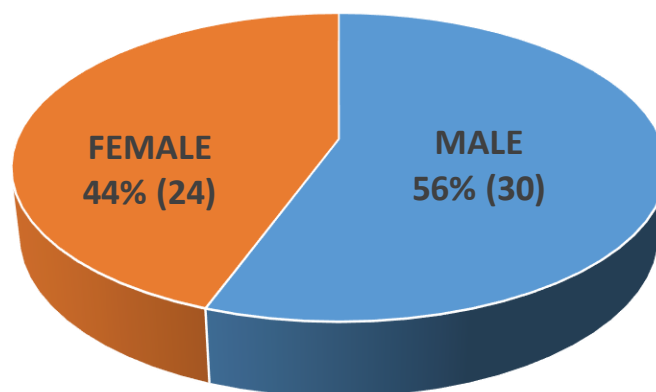
The graphs on the Daily and Total COVID-19 cases in the House of Representatives reflect the national case trend.



**Cases by Age Groups**

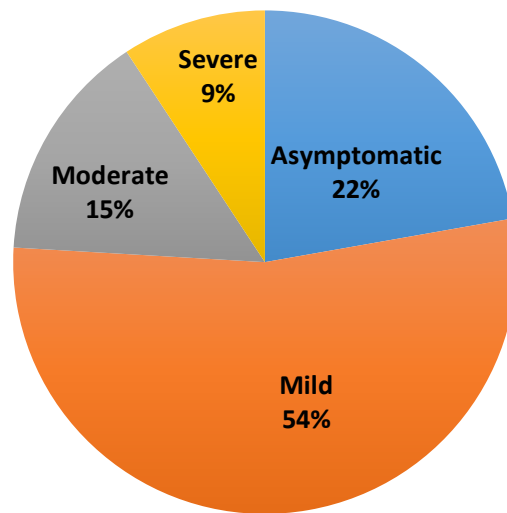


**Distribution by Sex**

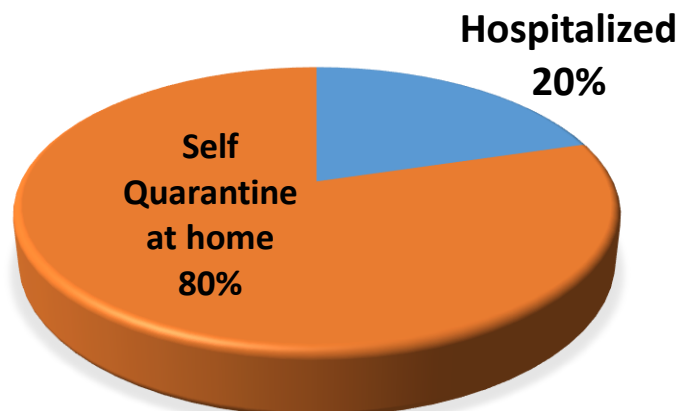


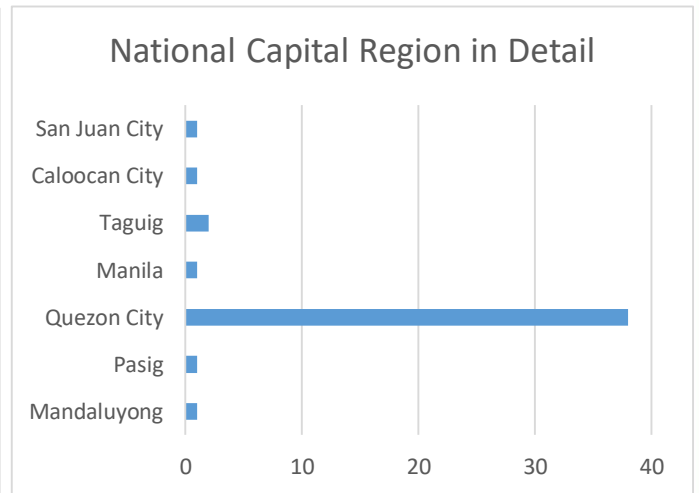
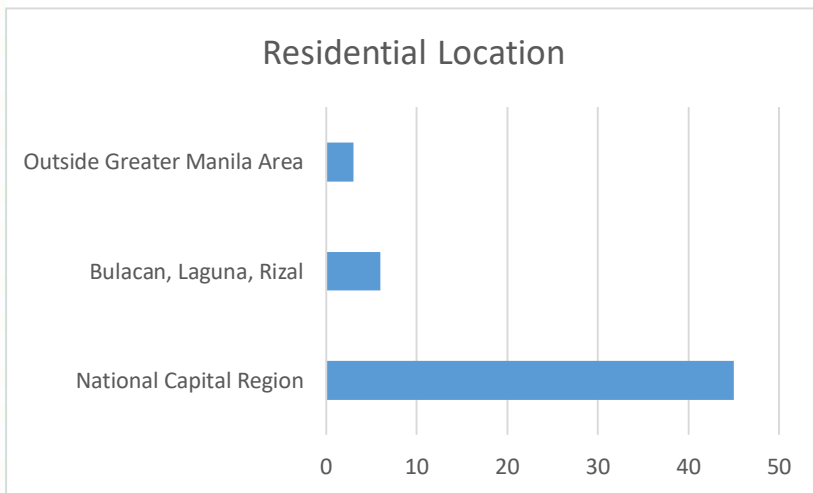
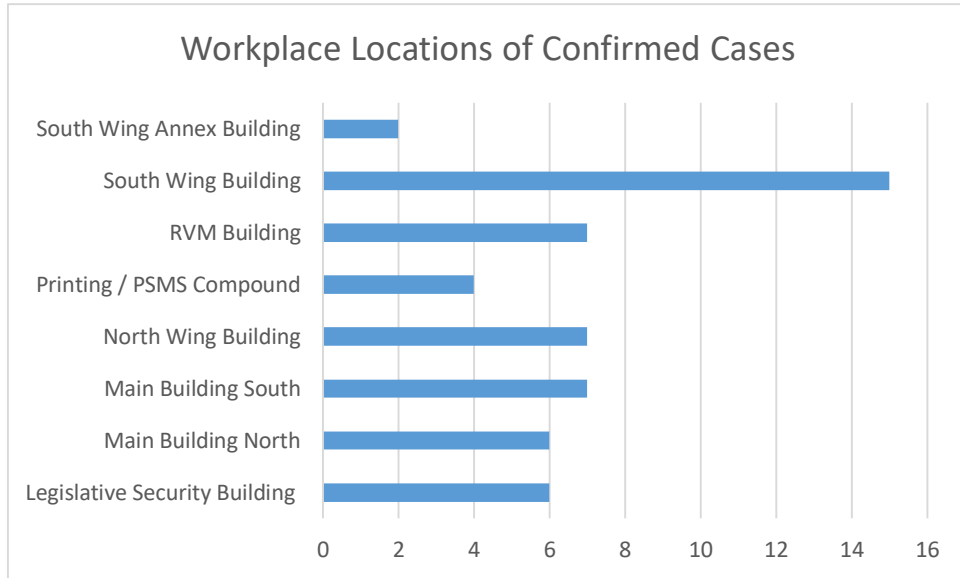


### Disposition of Total Confirmed Cases

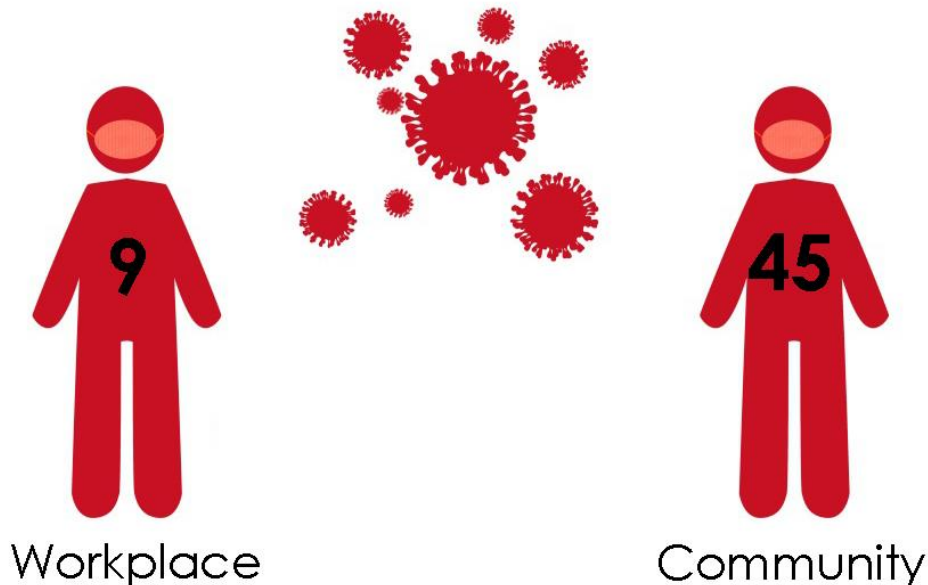

## Source of Transmission



The data strongly suggest that most of the confirmed cases were infected outside of HRep, i.e., while in their home province/city, while working from home, with no exposure to a confirmed case in HRep, or got infected by a family member who does not work in HRep.
