EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill seeks to rename the Central Taytay National High School to Judge Cesar L. Rodriguez Memorial High School amending for the purpose Republic Act 7982.

The late Judge Cesar L. Rodriguez is a benevolent and cause oriented citizen of Taytay, Palawan whose primordial goal is to achieve excellence in education and public service for the benefit of his province mates in particular and his countrymen in general.

In the year 1992, the late Judge Cesar L. Rodriguez spearheaded the acquisition of a private school and established a tuition- free institution for secondary education for the poor but deserving students of Taytay.

Recognizing the legacy, commitment, valuable efforts, love and dedication to education of Judge Rodriguez, renaming the said school is a heartfelt presentation of our gratitude for his selfless contributions. The immediate enactment of this bill is therefore earnestly sought.

AN ACT CHANGING THE NAME OF CENTRAL TAYTAY NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY POLBLACION, MUNICIPALITY OF TAYTAY PROVINCE OF PALAWAN TO JUDGE CESAR L. RODRIGUEZ MEMORIAL HIGH SCHOOL

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Renaming of National High School- The Central Taytay National High School in Barangay Poblacion, Municipality of Taytay, Province of Palawan is hereby changed to Judge Cesar L. Rodriguez Memorial High School amending for the purpose Republic Act No. 7982.

SECTION 2. Effectivity – This Act shall take effect fifteen days after its publication in the Official Gazette
