DEEPEST CONDOLENCES ON THE DEMISE OF THE SINGER-SONG
WRITER ARTIST MR. EMIL E. SANGLAY Jr.**

WHEREAS, Mr. Emil E. Sanglay Jr. is a Chemical Engineering graduate from the Mapua Institute of Technology and also completed his Advanced Education for Music Teachers and Musicians at the University of the Philippines, College of Music;

WHEREAS, Mr. Emil E. Sanglay Jr. joined our Creator at the age of 62 on December 17, 2015 due to cardiac arrest while he was in Baguio City;

WHEREAS, Mr. Emil E. Sanglay Jr. started his career when Vicor Records released his song "PEN-PEN DE SARAPEN" in 1978;

WHEREAS, Mr. Emil E. Sanglay Jr. was successful during his lifetime as a song writer and has won several awards in songwriting and music competitions including the METRO MANILA POPULAR MUSIC FESTIVAL (Metropop). He won in the said competition third place twice in 1981 with "Uhaw na Lupa" and again he won in the professional division in 1985 with "Anting Anting". He was also one of the TOP 100 Semi-Finalists in the USA Song Writing Contest in 2001. He was one of the multi-awarded composers/singers and neo-ethnic music artists in the country;


WHEREAS, Mr. Emil E. Sanglay Jr. was likewise a teacher in music with specialization in voice, guitar and in ethnic and world music lessons;
