EXPLANATORY NOTE

The attached Bill seeks the construction of a circumferential road from Cebu City's first district (North) to the second district (South).

Current economic activities in Cebu put in sharp focus the development potentials of the City of Cebu and Metro Cebu, towards making it a prime growth center and more. This kind of potentials and this kind of development, however, give rise to some areas of concern. With Cebu City's and Metro Cebu's projected growth, even the construction and improvement of basic infrastructures, roads, bridges and flood control facilities in selected areas to alleviate the serious traffic situation now obtaining will not be adequate in the near future, given the increasing and widening areas of traffic.

Thus, it is for the above cited reasons that the construction of a circumferential road is necessary in order to improve the transport and traffic situation in Cebu City and Metro Cebu.

HOUSE BILL NO. 274

AN ACT
PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CIRCUMFERENTIAL ROAD FROM CEBU
CITY'S FIRST DISTRICT (NORTH) TO THE SECOND DISTRICT (SOUTH)

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

SECTION 1. There shall be constructed under the supervision of the Department of Public Works and Highways a circumferential road from Cebu City's First District (North) to the Second District (South).

SEC. 2. The amount needed to implement the provisions of this Act shall be charged against the allocation of the Department of Public Works and Highways under the current General Appropriations Act thereafter such expenses as may be needed for its repair and maintenance shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in two (2) national newspapers of general circulation.
