

AN ACT DECLARING JANUARY 23, OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL NON-WORKING
HOLIDAY IN THE PROVINCE OF BULACAN

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress
assembled:*

SECTION 1. January 23 of every year is hereby declared a Special Non-working
Holiday in the Province of Bulacan.

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days from its publication in any
newspaper of general circulation
