

“AN ACT FURTHER AMENDING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9994, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS  
THE “EXPANDED SENIOR CITIZENS ACT OF 2010”

*Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in  
Congress assembled:*

**SECTION ONE.** *Additional Provision to Section 4 of R.A. 9994 be read as  
follows:*

**SECTION 4. PRIVILEGES FOR THE SENIOR CITIZENS**

“XXX

“(m)” Exemption from passport processing fee.

**SECTION TWO. Repealing Clause** – All laws, decrees, executive orders or  
parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed,  
amended or modified accordingly.

**SECTION THREE. This Act shall take effect immediately upon approval.**
