### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill seeks to convert the GSIS-Sampaguita Road in Barangay Calendola in the City of San Pedro, Province of Laguna, into a national road and appropriate funds for the maintenance and improvement thereof.

The GSIS-Sampaguita Road traverses three barangays namely Calendola, Riverside and Narra in the City of San Pedro. It provides access to different points in the community and serves as a viable link for trade and development, education, health, agriculture, energy and tourism.

Over the years, the GSIS-Sampaguita Road has deteriorated and now needs re-surfacing, re-alignment and installation of drainage structures. By converting it into a national road, the Department of Public Works and Highways can include it in its road maintenance and repair programs with funds from the national government. Thus, reconstruction and improvement could be properly undertaken.

In view of the foregoing, approval of this bill is highly recommended.

**AN ACT  
PROVIDING FOR THE CONVERSION OF THE GSIS-SAMPAGUITA  
ROAD IN BARANGAY CALENDOLA, MUNICIPALITY OF SAN PEDRO,  
PROVINCE OF LAGUNA, INTO A NATIONAL ROAD AND  
APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND  
IMPROVEMENT THEREOF**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines  
in Congress Assembled:*

SECTION 1. The GSIS-Sampaguita Road connecting Barangays Calendola, Riverside and Narra, in the City of San Pedro, Province of Laguna, is hereby converted into a national road under the supervision of the Department of Public Works and Highways.

SEC. 2. The Secretary of the Department of Public Works and Highways shall include in its program the improvement, maintenance and repair of the said road, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette.
