EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill proposes to convert a provincial road into a national road, beginning from the municipality of Butig in Lanao del Sur to the Municipality of Barira, which is already in Maguindanao but is part of the boundary dividing the two provinces.

Butig is a sixth class municipality in the province of Lanao del Sur. In the survey of 2010, it has a population of 16,642 people. It became a municipality under Executive Order No. 21 issued on June 25, 1963 during the term of President Diosdado Macapagal

The provincial road is a vital link to all the above-mentioned municipalities, whether going in or out of Lanao del Sur. People, products, businesses, even tourists and occasional visitors or *balikbayans*, all have access to the municipalities because of this provincial road.

Thus, to keep the road in the best condition, and so that progress will come to the municipalities, this road should be converted into a national road to ensure that there are funds for its maintenance, repair and probable expansion.

In view of the foregoing, the immediate passage of this bill is earnestly requested.

HOUSE BILL NO. 3782

Introduced by Honorable Mauyag "Jun" Papandayan, Jr.

AN ACT CONVERTING THE PROVINCIAL ROAD FROM THE MUNICIPALITY OF BUTIG IN THE SECOND DISTRICT OF LANA O DEL SUR TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF BARIRA IN MAGUINDANAO, INTO A NATIONAL ROAD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

Section 1. The provincial road from the Municipality of Butig going to the Province of Maguindanao, is hereby converted into a national road under the jurisdiction and supervision of the Department of Public Works and Highways.

SEC.2. The Secretary of Public Works and Highways shall include in the Department's program the improvement, repair and maintenance of the said road, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC.3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
