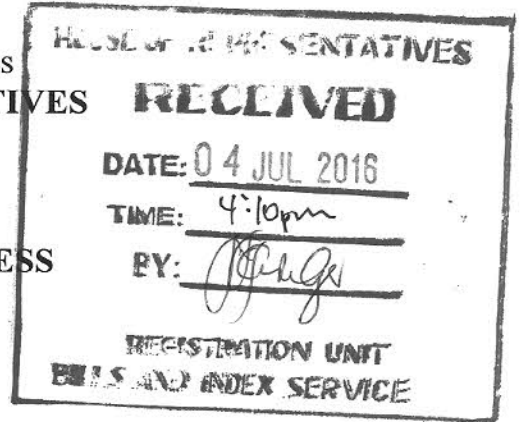

RESOLUTION

DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE COMMITTEES TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE STATEMENT OF THE CHIEF OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE ON THE ALLEGED INVOLVEMENT OF CERTAIN POLICE OFFICIALS IN THE ILLICIT DRUG TRADE AND OTHER ILLEGAL ACTIVITIES

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2016, the former Chief of the Davao City Police, Chief Superintendent Ronald M. dela Rosa, officially took over the reins of the Philippine National Police (PNP) as its new Director General;

WHEREAS, in his speech during the turn over ceremonies of the PNP leadership, Police Director General dela Rosa warned members of the PNP who are corrupt abusive, indolent, and members of a syndicate that their days are numbered, especially the police in Metro Manila who bragged that they are ninjas, recycling the shabu;

WHEREAS, this statement coming from no less than the head of the police organization, on the alleged involvement of certain active police personnel in the illicit drug trade and other illegal activities is a serious matter of national importance that needs to be looked into in order to determine its veracity, bases and extent;

WHEREAS, the continuing allegations on the alleged involvement of some police personnel has affected, and continues to affect, the integrity of the primary agency tasked to enforce the laws of the land and has, to some extent, affected its performance and credibility ;

WHEREAS, it is imperative that the PNP must have the continuing trust of the people in order that their cooperation may be expected in the fight against criminality and that these continuing allegations have affected the view and trust of the people in the police as their protectors and some have even developed fear of policemen;


WHEREAS, there is also need to examine the recruitment procedures, indoctrination, education, values formation, budget, intelligence and counter-intelligence, organizational procedures and structure and other factors in the Philippine National Police and the National

Police Commission in order to address the roots of the problem and pass remedial legislation if necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT, RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED TO

Direct The Appropriate Committees To Conduct An Inquiry, In Aid Of Legislation, On The Statement Of The Chief Of The Philippine National Police On The Alleged Involvement Of Certain Police Officials In The Illicit Drug Trade And Other Illegal Activities.
