RESOLUTION

CONDEMNING IN THE STRONGEST POSSIBLE TERMS THE DASTARDLY TERRORISTIC ATTACK IN DAVAO CITY, EXPRESSING SUPPORT TO PRESIDENT RODRIGO ROA DUTERTE IN HIS EFFORTS TO PREVENT OR SUPPRESS LAWLESS VIOLENCE IN THE COUNTRY, AND EXTENDING ITS DEEPEST CONDOLENCES AND SYMPATHIES TO THE FAMILIES OF THOSE KILLED AND INJURED

WHEREAS, in the evening of September 2, 2016, a bomb blast tore into a busy night market at Roxas Boulevard in Davao City that claimed the lives of fifteen people and left more than seventy others injured;

WHEREAS, the Abu Sayyaf Group (ASG), a jihadist terrorist organization based in Mindanao has claimed responsibility over the bombing attack and warned of more attacks in the coming days, following the intensified military operations against the group over the past week;

WHEREAS, after inspecting the blast site, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte authorized members of the Armed Forces of the Philippines and the Philippine National Police to gather intelligence information and conduct investigation and searches to get to the bottom of the terrorist attack;

WHEREAS, the House of Representatives stands in solidarity with the people of Davao City and the whole country in bringing to justice all those involved in the planning and execution of the terrorist attack:

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, To condemn in the strongest possible terms the dastardly terrorist attack in Davao City, to express support to President Rodrigo Roa Duterte in his efforts to prevent or suppress lawless violence in the country, and to extend its deepest condolences and sympathies to the families of those who were killed and injured.
