AND TO DETERMINE THE MONTHLY SALARY CREDITS, THE
SCHEDULE AND RATE OF CONTRIBUTIONS AND THE RATE
OF PENALTY ON DELINQUENT CONTRIBUTIONS AND
UNPAID LOAN AMORTIZATIONS, THEREBY FURTHER
AMENDING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 1161, AS AMENDED,
OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE SOCIAL SECURITY LAW

has considered the same and recommends that **House Bill No. 2158** be
approved, in consolidation with House Bills Numbered 1947, 2776, and 3550,
with the following amendments:

1. On page 1, line 1, delete the entire Section 1 and thereafter renumber the
Section title in line 2 as SECTION 1;
2. On the same page, line 7, delete the letters "X XX" enclosed in
parentheses and in lieu thereof, insert the following paragraph:

“(1) To adopt, amend and rescind [, subject to the
approval of the President of the Philippines,] such rules and
regulations as may be necessary to carry out the provisions
and purposes of this Act;
3. On page 3, line 4, renumber the section title from Section 3 to SECTION
2;
4. On the same page, line 21, delete the Section reference, which should
now read as SECTION 3;
5. On the same page and line, delete the phrase SEC. 3 between the
Section reference and the phrase Section 22;
6. Renumber all subsequent Sections accordingly;
7. The title of the bill shall read as follows:

AN ACT
RATIONALIZING AND EXPANDING THE POWERS AND DUTIES
OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY COMMISSION AND THE SOCIAL
SECURITY SYSTEM, FURTHER AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE
REPUBLIC ACT NO. 1161, AS AMENDED BY REPUBLIC ACT NO.
8282, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE ‘SOCIAL SECURITY ACT OF
1997’

with Reps. Pineda, Romero, Santos-Recto, Escudero, Relampagos, and Sacdalan as authors thereof.

AN ACT

RATIONALIZING AND EXPANDING THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY COMMISSION AND THE SOCIAL SECURITY SYSTEM, FURTHER AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 1161, AS AMENDED BY REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8282, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE 'SOCIAL SECURITY ACT OF 1997'

OBJECTIVE:

To vest the Social Security Commission (SSC) and the Social Security System (SSS) with powers and duties comparable to other social security agencies, e.g., Government Service Insurance System (GSIS), Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth), and Home Development Mutual Fund (Pag-IBIG), and their policy making bodies, thereby, allowing the SSC-SSS to respond with dispatch to clamor for additional benefits to its members or any threat to the sustainability of the social security fund.

KEY PROVISIONS:

- Authorizes the SSC-SSS to enter into a compromise or to release any interest, penalty, or any civil liability to SSS in connection with short and medium term loans to its members such as salary, educational, livelihood, marital, calamity and emergency loans, without need for approval from the President of the Philippines;
- Authorizes the SSC-SSS to condone, compromise or release, in whole or in part, on a case to case basis, such penalties imposed upon employers for delinquent social security contributions due to fiscal difficulties;
- Mandates the SSC-SSS to submit to Congress annual reports related to the exercise of the power to condone penalties for delinquent social security contributions/payments and to include the names, addresses, and other information on the delinquent employers; and
- Authorizes the SSC-SSS to determine the salary credits, schedule and rate of contributions, and rate of penalty on unremitted contributions and unpaid loan amortizations without need for approval from the President of the Philippines.
