THE PRIVILEGE HOUR

With the unanimous consent of the Body, on motion of Rep. Gerald Anthony “Samsam” V. Gullas Jr., the Chair declared a Privilege Hour and thereafter, recognized Deputy Speaker Gwendolyn F. Garcia for her privilege speech.

PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF DEPUTY SPEAKER GARCIA (G.)

With the help of an audio-visual documentary, Rep. Garcia first related how the Cebu Provincial Detention and Rehabilitation Center (CPDRC) was transformed into a world-renowned and world-class facility and became a source of pride, inspiration, and hope for rehabilitation and redemption of inmates thereof and for the country in general during her nine-year term as Cebu governor. Subsequently, she lamented how it disintegrated since Governor Hilario Davide III assumed office in 2013 and recounted the recent raids that yielded millions in cash money,

illegal drugs, gadgets and appliances, weapons, and drug paraphernalia among the inmates and jail guards within and outside of the center’s premises.

Rep. Garcia pointed out that all of the deaths and illegal activities of the inmates in the CPDRC happened during the term of Governor Davide and that she finds it ironic that the latter was cited by the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) as one of the 10 governors who have had stemmed the illegal drug trade in their respective provinces. As the Duterte Administration is making headway in the battle against the drug menace, she stressed that Governor Davide must be made to answer the issues and not skirt the matter by suggesting the transfer of the CPDRC management to the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology (BJMP). She reminded Governor Davide that as the provincial governor, he is the keeper of the provincial jail as provided for in Section 1731, Article III of the Revised Administrative Code of 1917 and Section 468, Article III of the 1991 Local Government Code (LGC).

Rep. Garcia stated that there was a failure in the leadership of Governor Davide and that she was duty-bound and it was her moral obligation, not just as the Representative of the Third District of Cebu but also as Cebu’s first woman-governor, to speak on the matter. She then informed the Body that she would file a resolution calling for an investigation, in aid of legislation, into the glaring deficiencies and gross mismanagement and administration of the CPDRC.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF GUESTS

At this point, Rep. Gullas acknowledged the presence in the Session Hall of guests of Rep. Cheryl P. Deloso-Montalla.

Thereafter, on motion of Rep. Gullas, the Chair recognized Rep. Benhur L. Salimbangon for his interpellation.

INTERPELLATION OF REP. SALIMBANGON

At the outset, Rep. Salimbangon congratulated Deputy Speaker Garcia (G.) for transforming the most hard-headed inmates of the CPDRC to the most popular inmates in the world via a viral dance presentation which was viewed all over the world. Both Members then discussed the manner by which Rep. Garcia was able to manage to transfer 1,400 inmates to a new jail facility during her term as Cebu Governor.

With respect to the transformation of the inmates, Rep. Garcia said that this was achieved through the dance and music programs of the Cebu Provincial Detention and Rehabilitation Center (CPDRC) with Mr. Byron Garcia as security consultant, and a competent choreographer who introduced the concept of dance to the inmates.

On the plan of the provincial governor to transfer the CPDRC to the BJMP, Rep. Garcia said that the former was skirting the issue of gross mismanagement, accountability and responsibility, this as she recalled that during her time as Governor, they worked hard and with passion to reform the inmates and run the jails efficiently. She said that in the nine years that she was Cebu Governor, she resisted the idea of transferring the provincial jail management to the BJMP, and for which reason she filed a resolution to find out why the CPDRC has turned from a source of pride to a source of shame and shabu; and to listen to the thoughts of the BJMP and the League of Governors; and be able to craft proper remedial laws.

Finally, she clarified what she had stated early on in her speech that according to newspaper reports, millions of pesos, kilos of shabu, cellphones, bladed weapons, and drug paraphernalia, among others, were found during the raid conducted in the provincial jail on August 13, 2016.

SUSPENSION OF THE PRIVILEGE HOUR

APPROVAL OF THE JOURNAL

On motion of Rep. Gullas, there being no objection, the Body approved Journal No. 16, dated August 30, 2016.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF GUESTS

Rep. Gullas acknowledged the presence in the Session Hall of guests of Rep. Gary C. Alejano.

RESUMPTION OF THE PRIVILEGE HOUR

On motion of Rep. Gullas, there being no objection, the Body resumed the Privilege Hour.

EXTENSION OF THE PRIVILEGE HOUR

On another motion of Rep. Gullas, there being no objection, the Body extended the Privilege Hour for 30 minutes.

REMARKS OF REP. GULLAS

Rep. Gullas stated that the parliamentary status was that the Body has resumed consideration of Deputy Speaker Garcia's (G.) privilege speech and thereafter the Chair recognized Rep. Arnolfo "Arnie" A. Teves Jr. for his interpellation.

INTERPELLATION OF REP. TEVES

Rep. Teves related to the Body a similar problem he had encountered in his Province of Negros Oriental where he alleged that the provincial governor was involved in drug pushing in their provincial jail. He then requested Deputy Speaker Garcia (G.) to include in her resolution an investigation on the employees and officials handling and supervising their provincial jail, including the Negros Oriental governor considering that the latter heads the provincial jail.

Rep. Garcia replied that another resolution has to be filed specifically on the investigation of the Negros Oriental provincial jail and that she would gladly co-author such measure. She surmised that once the resolutions have been filed and transmitted to the proper committee, they would be joined for proper investigation.

REFERRAL OF DEPUTY SPEAKER GARCIA'S (G.) PRIVILEGE SPEECH

On motion of Rep. Gullas, there being no objection, the Body referred the privilege speech of Rep. Garcia (G.) and the interpellations thereon to the Committee on Rules.

PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF REP. BORDADO

Recognized by the Chair, Rep. Gabriel H. Bordado Jr. from the Third District of Camarines Sur spoke about Memorandum Circular (MC) No. 9 issued by the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) Secretary, entitled, "Supplemental Guidelines on the Implementation of the Protective Services Program (PSP)," in relation to the Supreme Court decision declaring the unconstitutionality of the Priority Development Assistance Fund (PDAF). He said that the DSWD Circular underscores, among others, that "referral letters from individuals, group of individuals or organizations including public officials whether national or local executives, legislators, members of the Judiciary, or constitutional commissions are not integral to the implementation of the PSP and that the DSWD retains the sole authority to determine the beneficiaries of the program pursuant to existing guidelines."

As a neophyte Member, he said that he respects Secretary Judy Taguiwalo's position on the matter. However, he pointed out that there should be an effective and efficient system to ensure that qualified beneficiaries will have proper access to the program, and that an intensive information dissemination campaign is set up to avoid their constituents from blaming them for the inadequacies of the DSWD. In closing, he reminded the DSWD Secretary of President Duterte's vow to end the long queues for those who wish to avail themselves of government services.

REFERRAL OF REP. BORDADO'S PRIVILEGE SPEECH

On motion of Rep. Gullas, there being no objection, the Body referred the privilege speech of Rep. Bordado to the Committee on Rules.

SUSPENSION OF SESSION

On motion of Rep. Gullas, the Chair suspended the session at 5:39 p.m.

RESUMPTION OF SESSION

The session resumed at 5:39 p.m.

RESUMPTION OF THE PRIVILEGE HOUR

On motion of Rep. Defensor, there being no objection, the Body resumed the Privilege Hour.

RECONSIDERATION OF REFERRAL OF REP. BORDADO'S PRIVILEGE SPEECH

On motion of Rep. Defensor, there being no objection, the Body reconsidered the committee referral of the privilege speech of Rep. Bordado and the Chair recognized anew Rep. Bordado to answer the interpellation of Rep. Rolando G. Andaya Jr.

INTERPELLATION OF REP. ANDAYA

Reps. Andaya and Bordado discussed, among others, the DSWD memorandum circular which the former said must have been done hastily without consulting the Members of Congress because had the DSWD Secretary waited for the Supreme Court decision, she would have understood the situation at hand. Rep. Andaya then explained the Supreme Court decision when it declared unconstitutional any post-enactment intervention by Members of Congress, which meant that Senators and House Members cannot in any way participate in the release of funds after the budget has been passed.

Rep. Andaya further explained the different kinds of lump sum funds such as the PDAF and the Special Purpose Fund (SPF), and averred that what was declared unconstitutional was the act of a Senator or a Representative in giving a list on how the lump sum funds would be broken down or distributed.

As regards the Commission on Audit Memorandum dated March 1, 2016, which was issued as a joint circular with DSWD, Rep. Andaya underscored that while this MC can be construed with different interpretations, he said that the COA Circular did not do away with the referral letters signed by legislators but in fact, laid down the rules on how the referral letters would be treated. He averred that even if these are not an integral part, they can still be considered if the beneficiary is qualified. Furthermore, Rep. Andaya said that the DSWD Circular did not explain fully why the LGUs are not allowed to download the funds to their local MSWD when the COA Circular allowed funds to be put to the municipalities because of limited government organization. He then opined that the DSWD Circular is contrary to the COA Circular.

REFERRAL OF REP. BORDADO'S PRIVILEGE SPEECH

On a previous motion of Rep. Defensor, there being no objection, the Body referred the privilege speech of Rep. Bordado and the interpellation thereon to the Committee on Rules.

TERMINATION OF THE PRIVILEGE HOUR

Thereafter, on motion of Rep. Defensor, there being no objection, the Body terminated the Privilege Hour.
