TO THE COMMITTEE ON RULES

THE PRIVILEGE HOUR

With leave of the House, on motion of Rep. Alexandria P. Gonzales, there being no objection, the Chair declared a Privilege Hour and thereafter recognized Minority Leader Danilo E. Suarez.

PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF MINORITY LEADER SUAREZ

Adverting to President Rodrigo Roa Duterte’s State of the Nation Address (SONA) entitled “A Comfortable Life for All,” Minority Leader Suarez initially said that he had decided to merely enhance the same because it was hard to go against a Chief Executive who had a high rating. He then enumerated and explained the basic components of a comfortable life.

He said that communities should be drug-free, thus committing on behalf of the Minority to work for more funding for the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA). He added that hunger, poverty, unemployment, inflation, and the strength of the peso should be addressed. He also pointed out that the people should be able to trust the government in fighting corruption, stressing the need to amend the Procurement Law and investigating and penalizing big tax evaders. He cited better communication facilities which included the establishment of a national government portal and a national broadband plan; as well as the opening up of certain industries to foreign participation.

He subsequently cited economic self-reliance, saying this involved developing the local manufacturing industry; passing laws on incentives and tax breaks for local businesses; and ensuring that the President’s national policies would be implemented through his proposed national budget for 2018. A comfortable life, he stressed, could also be achieved under an environment of peace and sincere negotiation. Local infrastructure projects should employ residents where they are located and should be coordinated with the Congressmen concerned, he added.

INTERPELLATION OF REPRESENTATIVE ATIENZA

On motion of Representative Gonzales (A.P.), the Chair thereafter recognized Representative Atienza who observed that President Duterte’s speech failed to mention his promises of clearing the water bodies all over the country and solving the traffic problem in Metro Manila. Minority Leader Suarez pointed out that that the priority of the President was the drug problem and advised his colleague to raise these issues in the budget hearings with the agencies concerned.

After Representative Atienza and Minority Leader Suarez further discussed problems in the transportation sector such as mass transportation facilities, the former stressed that the Philippine National Police should

also address the breakdown of law and order especially in ordinary homes and families instead of just concentrating on the issue of drugs.

REFERRAL OF MINORITY LEADER SUAREZ' PRIVILEGE SPEECH

On motion of Representative Gonzales (A.P.), there being no objection, the Body referred Minority Leader Suarez' privilege speech to the Committee on Rules.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF GUESTS

At this point, Representative Gonzales (A.P.) acknowledged the presence in the Session Hall of guests of Rep. Mohamad Khalid Q. Dimaporo.

PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF REPRESENTATIVE DIMAPORO (M.K.)

Representative Dimaporo delved on the issuance by the National Police Commission (Napolcom) on June 28, 2017 of Resolution Nos. 334 and 335, series of 2017, withdrawing the deputation of governors and certain mayors of some provinces in Mindanao under Republic Act (R.A.) Nos. 6975 and 8851. He pointed that the same was due to their alleged failure to suppress terrorist elements within their jurisdiction and said officials found out about the same only on July 5, 2017 and from social media.

Surmising that the Napolcom based the resolutions on the attacks perpetrated by the Maute Group in Marawi from 2013 up to the present, Representative Dimaporo asked how the aforementioned officials failed to suppress said group if the Philippine National Police (PNP) and Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) never affirmed its existence in their province. Nevertheless, he stressed that the provincial government had been regularly convening peace and order meetings with the PNP and AFP; continued to be proactive about the threat posed not by the Maute Group but the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) and the New People's Army (NPA); and had asked the national government to remind the AFP to forbid the entry of the MILF in Lanao del Norte when the Bangsamoro Comprehensive Agreement was signed in the previous administration.

Representative Dimaporo cited more instances of how the local government units (LGUs) in his province had cooperated and supported the security forces in order to curb terror, after which he also surmised that said resolutions were issued allegedly because of

these LGUs' inaction in the war on drugs. Denying the truth thereof, he enumerated measures they had undertaken thereon and pointed out that it was the courts and prosecutors who were hindering the drug campaign.

Thereupon, Representative Dimaporo asked his colleagues to support a House Resolution that he had filed for an investigation on the matter and for the observance of due process.

On motion of Representative Gonzales (A.P.), the Chair recognized Rep. Edcel C. Lagman for his counter-SONA.

PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF REPRESENTATIVE LAGMAN

Representative Lagman initially thanked President Duterte for the Reproductive Health Law through the issuance of an executive order thereon, although he remarked that the Supreme Court had already issued a final decision upholding the temporary restraining order on its implementation of the law; teenage pregnancy in the country was still on the rise; high maternal deaths had not yet been contained; and the contraceptive prevalence rate still fell below international standards. He congratulated him as well for embarking on a program of extensive infrastructure development for which 70 percent of the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) by 2022 would be earmarked, but expressed hope that the Chief Executive will be wary of China's failed infrastructure projects in other countries and that public-private partnership projects will be actually implemented and will not be abandoned in favor of foreign construction companies. He also welcomed the President's announcement that environmental protection must be prioritized over mining operations, although rued the fact that former Environment Secretary Gina Lopez' appointment had not been confirmed.

Thereupon, Representative Lagman adverted to President Duterte's failure to eradicate the drug problem within three months of his assumption into office as he had promised; and to the unabated drug menace even after the Chief Executive's request for a six-month extension for the same. He stressed that the President refused to realize that the drug problem was both a health and poverty issue and not simply a police matter; had relentlessly embarked on a deadly campaign against drug users and traffickers despite the failure of such a policy in other countries from international leaders, global human rights bodies, and local advocates. He opined that the President's campaign against drug dealers and users was the centerpiece of

human rights transgression that ran counter to the Constitution; and added the insistence on the reimposition of the death penalty instead of the modern concept of penology as reformatory justice also exacerbated the human rights situation.

Then adverting to the proposed tax reform program, Representative Lagman posited that it could further ignite the inflation rate and was disadvantageous to low-income workers; and proposed that it contain safeguards to protect vulnerable sectors from new or additional excise taxes despite the government's need to raise revenue.

Representative Lagman next discussed the escalating traffic mess in Metro Manila and other urban centers.

He then adverted to the labor sector as he cited statistics on unemployment and underemployment; the persistence of labor contractualization; and the continuous implementation of Department Order 174 that merely intensified its regulation of independent service contractors.

He also dwelt on the President's concept of "independent foreign policy," stressing that it was belittling or even rejecting traditional diplomatic and trade partners such as the United States and European Union countries and unquestionably tying the knot with China and Russia. He expressed concern about the dalliance with China which would affect Philippine sovereignty.

On the President's campaign promise of pursuing peace talks with the Communist Party of the Philippines-National Democratic Front (CPP-NDF), Representative Lagman subsequently observed how this was abandoned upon the declaration of martial law and suspension of the writ of *habeas corpus*. He rued the destruction of Marawi and stressed that the city was never taken by the extremists and the soldiers and policemen were always ascendant over the Maute group and Abu Sayyaf; and the siege thereof only led to the deaths of soldiers and civilians and massive destruction of properties. At no instance, he stressed, was the Philippine Republic's sovereignty really imperiled and its territorial integrity compromised.

Noting the lack of time, Representative Lagman then said that he would address the President's legislative agenda in a separate privilege speech.

EXTENSION OF THE PRIVILEGE HOUR

On motion of Representative Gonzales (A.P.), there being no objection, the Chair extended the Privilege

Hour for another 30 minutes, and thereafter recognized Rep. Tom S. Villarín for his interpellation.

INTERPELLATION OF REPRESENTATIVE VILLARIN

Representatives Lagman and Villarín both agreed that the extension of martial law would not address the deterioration of poverty in Mindanao and would even escalate the issue of internally-displaced persons (IDPs) as it could result to a looming humanitarian crisis. Both Members also agreed that the challenge for the government of resolving the conflict and cycle of violence in Mindanao was through the continuation of the peace process, but a militarist policy would contradict the enactment of the Bangsamoro Basic Law.

Representative Villarín opined that the continuation of the peace process was the only option so that prosperity, development, and sustainable peace would be achieved in Mindanao.

Representative Lagman stated that peace would never emanate from the barrel of a gun but from sustained reforms by the government.

REFERRAL OF REPRESENTATIVE LAGMAN'S PRIVILEGE SPEECH

On motion of Representative Gonzales (A.P.), there being no objection, the Body referred the privilege speech of Representative Lagman to the Committee on Rules.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF GUESTS

Thereupon, Representative Gonzales (A.P.) acknowledged the presence in the Session Hall of guests of Rep. Aurora Enerio Cerilles.

On further motion of Representative Gonzales, the Chair recognized Rep. Anthony M. Bravo, Ph. D. for his privilege speech.

PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF REPRESENTATIVE BRAVO (A.)

In his speech, Representative Bravo initially spoke on the initiatives of the Duterte Administration in helping the cooperatives achieve sustainable and inclusive growth such as the issuance of Executive Order (E.O.) No. 1, placing the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) and 11 agencies representing the basic sectors directly under the Office of the President; abolition of irrigation service fees; and the Pondo Para sa Pagbabago Program launched by the Department of Trade and Industry to address the need of microenterprises and entrepreneurs for credit.

As he stressed that cooperatives were strong partners of the government in uplifting the lives of the poor and underprivileged Filipinos, Representative Bravo expressed gratitude on behalf of the cooperatives sector to Speaker Alvarez and the House leadership for retaining the tax exemption of the cooperatives in the proposed tax reform measure. He added that while some fake or bogus cooperatives were abusing the tax privileges, it was not right to punish the cooperative sector which generated jobs and paid taxes and that it will help police its own ranks.

At this point, Representative Bravo stressed that the government should strengthen the CDA and equip it with the necessary resources so that it can continue performing its regulatory and supervisory functions, and augment proper auditing of cooperatives. He likewise urged the Body to decide whether the CDA would be transformed into a department or remain a commission aside from including a cooperative representative in local governance and passing the bill mandating the appointment of cooperative development officers from barangay to provincial levels. He also stressed his sector's support for the Senate's passage of the tax reform measure and the Duterte Administration's socio-economic agenda and poverty-reduction initiatives.

REFERRAL OF REPRESENTATIVE BRAVO'S PRIVILEGE SPEECH

Thereupon, on motion of Rep. Salvador B. Belaro Jr., there being no objection, the Body referred the privilege speech of Representative Bravo to the Committee on Rules.

TERMINATION OF THE PRIVILEGE HOUR

Subsequently, on motion of Representative Belaro, there being no objection, the Body terminated the Privilege Hour.

APPROVAL OF THE JOURNAL

On further motion of Representative Belaro, there being no objection, the Body approved Journal No. 1, dated July 24, 2017.

ADJOURNMENT OF SESSION

Thereafter, on motion of Representative Belaro, there being no objection, the Chair declared the session adjourned until four o'clock in the afternoon of Wednesday, July 26, 2017.
