PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF REP. TEVES

Good afternoon, everybody.

Sa tingin ko, kailangan natin klaruhin kung ano talaga ang proper protocol sa mga ganitong pangyayari. Kailangan bang mag-apply ng search warrant or hindi?

Sa nangyayari kasi ngayon, kung ang provincial jail ay under sa control ng isang gobernador, ang lumalabas ay kailangan mong magpaalam sa gobernador. Papaano kung iyong gobernador ang nagtatago ng droga sa provincial jail? What happens now?

I think we should call our agencies to a meeting or a briefing para maklaro sa isa't isa kung ano ba talaga ang dapat gawin sa iba't ibang sitwasyon o pangyayari sa ating mga kulungan, more so when it is about drugs within our jails.

Ngayon kasi, dahil sa nangyari sa Leyte may mga tanong na: bakit may search warrant?

One time, nag-suggest ako na sa Bilibid, mag-apply ng search warrant, pero may nagsabi na hindi na dapat.

That is why I rise today to urge our agencies to sit down maybe here in Congress para klaruhin natin kung ano ba talaga ang mga kailangan, or ano ba talaga ang tamang protocol on how to go about or what is the procedure in searches or kung may kailangan hulihin sa loob ng isang kulungan.
