With the consent of the Committee on Local Government as well as the respective authors of the Bills, on motion of Representative Noel, there being no objection, the Body concurred with the Senate amendments to the following measures:

 House Bill No. 5367, entitled: "AN ACT REAPPORTIONING THE SIXTH AND SEVENTH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS OF THE PROVINCE OF CAVITE TO CREATE AN ADDITIONAL LEGISLA-TIVE DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AS THE EIGHTH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT OF THE PROVINCE OF CAVITE"; and

2. House Bill No. 5160, entitled: "AN ACT CONVERTING THE MUNICIPALITY OF STO.TOMAS IN THE PROVINCE OF BATANGAS INTO A COMPONENT CITY TO BE KNOWN AS THE CITY OF STO. TOMAS."

### SUSPENSION OF SESSION

The session was suspended at 6:24 p.m. upon motion of Majority Leader Andaya.

# RESUMPTION OF SESSION

The session resumed at 6:24 p.m.

# BUSINESS FOR THE DAY: COMMITTEE REPORT NO. 739 ON HOUSE BILL NO. 7735

On motion of Majority Leader Andaya, there being no objection, the Body considered on Second Reading House Bill No. 7735 contained in Committee Report No. 739 as reported out by the Committees on Agriculture and Food, Ways and Means, and Appropriations.

Upon direction of the Chair, the Secretary General read the title of the Bill, to wit:

"AN ACT REPLACING THE QUANTITATIVE IMPORT RESTRICTIONS ON RICE WITH TARIFFS AND CREATING THE RICE COMPETITIVENESS ENHANCEMENT FUND."

As copies of the Bill had been distributed to the Members, on motion of Majority Leader Andaya, there being no objection, the Body dispensed with the reading of the text of the measure without prejudice to its insertion into the Record of the House.

Thereafter, on motion of Majority Leader Andaya, the Chair recognized Rep. Jose T. Panganiban Jr. CPA, LLB, Chairperson of the Committee on Agriculture, for his sponsorship speech.

# SPONSORSHIP SPEECH OF REPRESENTATIVE PANGANIBAN

Representative Panganiban emphasized the aim of House Bill No. 7735 to provide balance between the government's commitment to the World Trade

Organization (WTO) and the protection of the welfare of the Filipino rice farmers and consumers. He recalled the Philippines' commitment to remove all non-tariff barriers in agriculture when it joined the WTO, and thereafter enumerated the key provisions of the measure, such as the mandate it gives to the National Food Authority (NFA) to undertake rice importation, issue guidelines for rice and corn exportation, provide for the composition of the NFA Council, and create the Rice Fund.

Moreover, he underscored that the measure empowers the President to adjust the applied rate, regulate rice exports, impose regulations on the volume of rice imports, and enter into rice trade negotiations. He concluded that rice tariffication could no longer be postponed, and appealed to the Members to support the measure.

# SUSPENSION OF CONSIDERATION ON SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILL NO. 7735

On motion of Majority Leader Andaya, there being no objection, the Body suspended the consideration on Second Reading of House Bill No. 7735.

# REMARKS OF MAJORITY LEADER ANDAYA

Majority Leader Andaya stated that the Body would proceed with the interpellations on the Privilege Speech delivered by Rep. Romero "Miro" S. Quimbo the previous day, but which would first be preceded by the delivery of Rep. Raul A. Daza's question of personal and collective privilege, subject to the understanding that the same would be limited to 15 minutes.

He said that thereafter, four other Members would take the floor in the following order: Reps. Rodel M. Batocabe, Carlos Isagani T. Zarate, Antonio L. Tinio, and Tom S. Villarin, to continue with the debate on who should be the Minority Leader, which position was being claimed by Reps. Danilo E. Suarez, Rodolfo C. Fariñas, Eugene Michael B. De Vera, and Representative Quimbo.

# QUESTION OF PRIVILEGE OF REPRESENTATIVE DAZA

Recognized by the Chair on motion of Majority Leader Andaya, Representative Daza stated for the record that he took the floor in reference to Representative Fariñas' statement the previous day that affects the dignity and reputation of the House of Representatives, as well as his duties, conduct, rights and privileges as a Member representing the First District of Northern Samar.

He emphasized that the issue of who constitutes the Minority is simple because it should be decided on irreversible facts of record and irrefutable provisions of the Rules of the House and a Supreme Court decision. He recalled the election of the Speaker on July 25, 2016; the recognition of Representative Suarez as the Minority Leader by the leadership; and the case of *Baguilat vs. Alvarez* before the Supreme Court that focused on the definition of membership under Section 8 of the House Rules.

As he cited to the Body the ruling of the Supreme Court in the *Baguilat vs. Alvarez* case and what had transpired during the voting for speakership of the House on July 25, 2016, Representative Daza informed the Body that the Baguilat group lost in said case as the Supreme Court upheld former Majority Leader Fariñas' interpretation of Section 8 of the amended Provisional Rules of the House.

As there are three groups presently vying for the Minority status in the House, Representative Daza maintained that his group consisting of 12 Members who voted to abstain in the election of the new Speaker is indubitably the Minority under the *Baguilat vs. Alvarez* ruling. He claimed that the Suarez group, having voted for Speaker Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo, clearly belongs to the Majority, and noted that the Fariñas group did not vote at all.

He stressed that the contention of the Suarez group that Section 8 does not apply to the present situation as it covers only the organization of the House at the beginning of each Congress was untenable both under the amended Rules and the Baguilat vs. Alvarez ruling as Rule I of the Rules of the House provides for the convening and organizing the House while Section 8 under Rule II provides for membership. He stated that if the intent of Section 8 was to apply only when the House convenes and organizes itself for a new Congress, Section 8 would have been under Rule I and not under Rule II. Likewise citing the legal maxim "Where the law does not distinguish, neither should we distinguish," he said that Section 11, Rule III does not differentiate between the election of the Speaker at the commencement of Congress and an election whenever there is a vacancy.

As to the contention of the Fariñas group that they constitute the Minority as they did not vote in

the election of Speaker Macapagal-Arroyo, Representative Daza stated that said contention is beset by a veritable physical obstacle as it is physically impossible to determine the mindset of those present during the July 23, 2018 session that did not vote for Speaker Macapagal-Arroyo. He opined that Section 8 classifies the Fariñas group as independents as they are neither aligned with the Majority nor the Minority.

Thereupon, he stated that he finds the statement of Representative Fariñas tenuous by saying that the President's legislative agenda would be at risk if the members of the Liberal Party (LP) becomes the Minority.

# REMINDER FROM THE CHAIR

At this point, the Chair reminded Representative Daza that his 15 minutes time allotment had already elapsed and requested the latter to wind up his speech to which he replied that he will do so in five minutes.

# QUESTION OF PRIVILEGE OF REPRESENTATIVE DAZA

(Continuation)

Continuing with his speech, Representative Daza explained why the LP is not an obstructionist group even though they belong to the opposition by citing several Administration measures that they have supported as well as the support of certain LP members to the candidacy of Speaker Macapagal-Arroyo and Senate President Vicente Sotto III.

He then submitted that the decision of the House leadership in the determination of the Minority should be that of values that must endure in a true and functional democracy and not by entrenched mechanisms, clever semantics, or pragmatic politics.

### REMARKS OF THE CHAIR

At this point, the Chair stated that Representative Daza had already exceeded his five minutes extension.

Representative Daza then requested for a twominute extension which the Chair denied.

Thereafter, the Chair recognized Representative Fariñas for his interpellation of Representative Daza.

# INTERPELLATION OF REPRESENTATIVE FARIÑAS

At the outset, Representative Daza affirmed he was one of the petitioners in the *Baguilat vs. Alvarez* case. In response to Representative Fariñas' query on whether the so-called Magnificent Seven had wanted the Supreme Court to rule against the House of Representatives about an alleged grave abuse of discretion, Representative Daza cited the Supreme Court ruling that would help Congress determine on who shall form part of the Majority and Minority blocs and who will be the Minority Leader after an election for Speaker had taken place.

Refuting the claim of Representative Daza that he and his other colleagues opted not to participate in the recent election for Speaker, Representative Fariñas stated for the record that said nonparticipation was not a neglect of duty but rather a lack of knowledge and information that such a proceeding would take place. He further explained how events had transpired before and after President Rodrigo Roa Duterte delivered his State of the Nation Address (SONA) on July 23, 2018. He pointed out that there was no quorum bell, that that day's session was already adjourned at 12:45 p.m., and a session before the SONA was never called.

While Representative Fariñas praised Rep. Edcel C. Lagman for questioning the proceedings prior to the SONA, he criticized then Deputy Speaker Quimbo for not intervening as well as some of his LP colleagues for passively participating, playing possum, and goading the Minority to vote and join the Majority for them to get the 161 votes.

Adverting to the adoption of House Resolution No. 2025, Representative Fariñas said that their supposed independence as a result of their nonparticipation in the election for Speaker was a skewed interpretation of House Rules. He averred that the House Rules provide that the House will start its daily sessions at 4:00 p.m., and noted that a session was conducted in the evening of July 23, 2018 without him, as the Majority Leader then, being informed thereof. He affirmed that he recognizes the speakership of Speaker Macapagal-Arroyo. He however asked whether Representative Daza recognizes the Supreme Court ruling on the Baguilat case which his group previously filed, that the Suarez group was the validly constituted Minority in the House and not Representative Daza's group.

Representative Daza countered Representative Fariñas' observation that the LP agitated the rump session and pointed out that it was even Representative Fariñas who admitted that the proceedings was

already defined by a resolution. He said that he could not imagine that the 199 Members who actually voted were not notified and the then Majority Leader Fariñas whose office was located just at the back of the Session Hall being not aware of what was going on in the Session Hall.

### REMARKS OF THE CHAIR

The Chair remarked that House Resolution No. 2025 was the best evidence for the accurate number of votes on the election of Speaker. He also stated that the questions of Representative Fariñas had been sufficiently answered, and thereafter ruled that the Body proceed with the interpellation of Representative Quimbo.

# INTERPELLATION OF REPRESENTATIVE FARIÑAS

(Continuation)

Upon recognition by the Chair, Representative Fariñas commented that Representative Daza did not answer his question on whether the latter recognizes the Supreme Court ruling on the *Baguilat* case that the Suarez group was the duly constituted Minority in the House.

With the Chair's permission, Representative Daza replied in the affirmative by saying that was how the high tribunal decided on the case. He opined that the decision was binding on all the Members, including the group of Representative Fariñas.

Representative Fariñas said he was not satisfied with the reply but would nonetheless already terminate his interpellation.

Subsequently, on motion of Majority Leader Andaya, the Chair recognized Rep. Rodel M. Batocabe for his interpellation on the privilege speech of Representative Quimbo.

# INTERPELLATION OF REPRESENTATIVE BATOCABE

On questions about his status as a Deputy Speaker of the House, Representative Quimbo stated that he no longer held the position when he became a member of the Minority by virtue of his abstention in the election of a new Speaker, as well as his subsequent election as Minority Leader. This, he said, was based on the provision of Section 8 of the amended Provisional House Rules.

Representative Batocabe then quoted a provision under Rule III of the House Rules which particularly stated the manner by which House officials and officers could be elected and removed from office.

Thereupon, Representatives Batocabe and Quimbo debated on (1) the consequence of the Members' votes in the election of the new Speaker and (2) the effect of the election of the new Speaker on the organization of the House.

Representative Quimbo pointed out that his position of Deputy Speaker was vacated in view of his resignation upon his election to the position of Minority Leader; and that although the Members automatically became part of the Majority or Minority after voting on the speakership, the Deputy Speakers are not automatically considered as having resigned from their positions. He said that some Members who were originally from the Minority, had become Deputy Speakers; and the House Rules provide for the election of House officers by the Members regardless of their membership in the Majority or Minority.

He also held that if a Committee Chairperson votes against the new Speaker, he remains the Chairperson even if he is no longer part of the Majority. He cited Rule II of the House Rules as he explained that one's vote in the election of the Speaker affects his membership in the Majority or Minority but not his chairmanship.

Further, he stressed that the Majority had to be distinguished from the Minority in order to ensure a system of check and balance in the Chamber.

For his part, Representative Batocabe explained that the Members elected a new Speaker because they had a right to elect a new leader and not because they wanted to determine who will comprise the Majority or Minority. He added that the Speaker is not a member of the Majority or Minority but is the administrative and political head of the House.

Representative Batocabe pointed out that Section 13 refers only to the vacancy of the Speaker and not in determining the membership of the Majority and Minority. He asked the Members to give Representative Suarez the chance to prove that he can be an effective Minority Leader because he does not think that personal association or even connection should be the standard in determining who will be the Minority Leader. He maintained that the Minority has already been constituted, therefore they

should allow Minority Leader Suarez to perform his duty to serve as their leader and to act as the check and balance or the fiscalizer of the House and if he fails to do so, it should be the people that should judge him and not the Members. Considering that the Majority and the Minority have already been constituted, he advised that Members who want to join the Minority or the Majority to follow the proper procedure. He maintained that the Speaker should neither be a member of the Majority or the Minority because the Speaker's mandate is to preside over the Body.

At this point, Representative Quimbo asked that he be allowed to respond for he still has the floor.

# **QUESTION OF QUORUM**

Rep. Jose L. Atienza Jr. moved to adjourn the session because the Members were not enough to constitute a quorum. He however thanked Representative Batocabe for clarifying the issue but they cannot learn anything anymore because there was no quorum.

# ELECTION OF REPRESENTATIVE ERMITA-BUHAIN TO THE COMMITTEE ON ACCOUNTS

Whereupon, on motion of Majority Leader Andaya, there being no objection, the Body elected Rep. Elenita Milagros "Eileen" Ermita-Buhain as Vice Chairperson of the Committee on Accounts.

# MANIFESTATION OF REPRESENTATIVE QUIMBO

Representative Quimbo sought recognition of the Chair.

### ADJOURNMENT OF SESSION

Thereupon, on motion of Majority Leader Andaya, there being no objection, the Chair declared the session adjourned until four o'clock in the afternoon of Wednesday, August 1, 2018.
