With 165 [162] affirmative votes, seven [10] negative votes, and no abstentions, the Body approved on Third Reading House Bill No. 7376.*

EXPLANATION OF VOTES

The following Members explained their votes:

1. Representative Casilao said that the Bill was an outright historical revisionism, with its goal of further strengthening the functions of the Office of the Solicitor General (OSG) simply a smoke screen. He said that although it includes a provision to absorb the employees of the Presidential Commission on Good Government (PCGG), its creation implied not only a government institution that retrieves or recovers the ill-gotten wealth of the late President Ferdinand E. Marcos but was also a product of a collective action of the Filipino people to oust a dictator and recover the ill-gotten wealth of the Marcoses. He then voted “No” to the measure.
2. Representative Castro (F.L.) voted “No” to House Bill No. 7376 because the measure provides too much power to the Solicitor General; its merging of the three offices would result to mass layoff; promotes conflict of interest; and demeans the function of the PCGG to recover the ill-gotten wealth of the Marcoses. She then cited the important functions of the PCGG to correct the wrongs committed against the Filipino people by the Marcoses and their cronies, fulfill the constitutional mandate on transparency and accountability of public officers, and prevent crony capitalism and dissipation of public wealth.
3. Representative Tinio explained his negative vote to House Bill No. 7376 on the following grounds: it would abolish the PCGG and the Office of the Government Corporate Counsel (OGCC) which was part of the Duterte Administration’s program on the rightsizing of the government bureaucracy and mass layoff of government employees; it would only benefit the Solicitor General and the employees of the OSG; and its abolition of the PCGG will weaken the government’s power to recover the remaining ill-

gotten wealth of the Marcoses thus demonstrating the Duterte Administration’s support to resuscitate the power and wealth of the Marcoses.

4. In explaining his negative vote, Representative Zarate said the Bill does not only strengthen but also provides super powers to the OSG; disregards the historical and triumphant people power that ousted the late President Marcos and his cronies and the collective action to recover their ill-gotten wealth; would result in the mass layoff of government employees instead of providing for their security of tenure; and would encourage more corruption in the government and promote conflict of interest considering that the OSG will be the lawyer of government-owned and -controlled corporations.

Whereupon, on motion of Representative Lopez (B.), there being no objection, the Chair recognized Representative Tinio for his question of privilege.

QUESTION OF PRIVILEGE OF REPRESENTATIVE TINIO

Representative Tinio discussed the Supreme Court (SC) decision to remove Chief Justice Sereno from office based on a quo warranto petition. He cited the pertinent constitutional provisions to underscore that the only way to get rid of the Chief

Justice of the Supreme Court is through impeachment proceedings. However, he stressed that the SC decision that took place last week violated and suppressed the very clear guideline set by the Constitution.

Representative Tinio lamented the fact that the SC ruling on the quo warranto petition had easily made impeachment as a mere option instead of being the only way to remove impeachable high-ranking government officials. He added that impeachment cases could not be acted and decided upon by the Supreme Court and that Congress has the exclusive power to decide on impeachment complaints as provided for in the Constitution. He further related that an impeachment proceeding was necessary in order to maintain checks and balance and avoid abuse of power, tyranny, and one-man rule.

Representative Tinio challenged his colleagues to defend the constitutional right, power, and mandate of Congress to remove a Supreme Court chief justice or other impeachable government officials.

MOTION TO REFER REPRESENTATIVE TINIO'S SPEECH

At this point, Representative Lopez (B.) moved to refer the speech of Representative Tinio to the Committee on Rules for its appropriate action.

MANIFESTATION OF REPRESENTATIVE MARCOLETA

Before the Body could act on the motion, Rep. Rodante D. Marcoleta manifested his intent to interpellate Representative Tinio.

SUSPENSION OF SESSION

On motion of Representative Noel, the session was suspended at 5:49 p.m.

RESUMPTION OF SESSION

The session resumed at 5:54 p.m.

MANIFESTATION OF REPRESENTATIVE LOPEZ (B.)

Upon resumption of session, Representative Lopez manifested that Representative Marcoleta had withdrawn his previous manifestation.

REFERRAL OF REPRESENTATIVE TINIO'S SPEECH

As previously moved by Representative Lopez (B.), there being no objection, the Body referred the

speech of Representative Tinio to the Committee on Rules for its appropriate action.

MANIFESTATION OF REPRESENTATIVE BROSAS

Recognized by the Chair on motion of Representative Lopez (B.), Representative Brosas stated that the recent SC ruling on the quo warranto petition against Chief Justice Sereno was a clear disregard for justice and democracy in a nation which has three separate but co-equal branches of government. She decried President Rodrigo Roa Duterte's unprecedented effort to remove CJ Sereno and how the high tribunal robbed the Legislature of its power over impeachable government officials, which she said would set as a precedent to future usurpation and abuse of power by other branches of government.

She then urged her colleagues to make a firm stand to reclaim its sole legal power and obligation to try and unseat an impeachable public official.

The Chair noted Representative Brosas' manifestation.

On further motion of Representative Lopez, the Chair recognized Representative Elago for her manifestation.

MANIFESTATION OF REPRESENTATIVE ELAGO

Initially expressing support for an impeachment proceeding in Congress, Representative Elago slammed the Supreme Court for making a preemptive action despite the fact that the impeachment complaint against CJ Sereno had already been deliberated at the House committee level. She thereafter asked for her colleagues' support not to let another branch of government usurp the power of legislators, and to decide on the Articles of Impeachment pending in Congress and eventually transmit it to the Senate for regular conduct of impeachment.

The Chair noted Representative Elago's manifestation.

On motion of Representative Lopez (B.), the Chair also recognized Representative Zarate for his manifestation.

MANIFESTATION OF REPRESENTATIVE ZARATE

Representative Zarate said that the ouster of CJ Sereno was clearly a political matter with the Supreme Court's usurping of the power of Congress to

remove an impeachable official by way of rewriting the Constitution and inserting another provision giving the mandate to impeach officials not only by impeachment process but even by quo warranto proceedings. He noted that it appears that a mere provision in the Rules of Court can now trump constitutional provisions and castrate the power of Congress to remove an impeachable official and to convict the evidential warrants of impeachable officials.

He called upon Congress, especially the House of Representatives to assert its role by asking the SC justices to set aside its ruling. Considering that the Members have already approved the Resolution on the Impeachment Complaint against CJ Sereno, he asked the House leadership to transmit to the Senate the Articles of Impeachment so that they can begin the trial of the Chief Justice and undergo the process laid out in the Constitution.

The Chair noted Representative Zarate's manifestation.
