Pursuant to Section 22.5 of the 2016 Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. (RA) 9184, this Bid Bulletin is being issued to amend and/or clarify the following provisions/portions of the Bidding Documents relative to the above-mentioned project.

I. AMENDMENTS

The following provisions/portions of the Biddings Documents are hereby amended,¹ as follows:

6. Upon termination of the contract or the completion of the project, all Confidential Information furnished to _____ shall be promptly returned to the HREP, or at the HREP's express request, shall be destroyed. The

destruction, should be witnessed and confirmed by a representative of the HREP.

7. _____ shall also turn-over to the HREP all copies of the schematic diagrams, drawings, lay-outs, blue prints, as-built plans and other documents _____ produced in the course of the completion of the project.
8. _____ shall not use the Confidential Information for purpose other than compliance with its obligation as a Contractor under Republic Act No. 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations.
