A RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS (DPWH) AND THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (DoTr) TO NOTIFY AND REGULARLY APPRISE METRO MANILA DISTRICT REPRESENTATIVES ON ANY PROPOSED/ONGOING MAJOR/FLAGSHIP GOVERNMENT INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENTS IN THEIR RESPECTIVE CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS

WHEREAS, part of President Rodrigo Duterte's Socioeconomic Agenda is the acceleration of the country's infrastructure developments through the "Build, Build, Build" Program to speed up economic growth;

WHEREAS, the government is looking at seventy-five (75) flagship infrastructure projects all over the Philippines worth up to Php 9 trillion with a number of them slated for Metro Manila including new bridges and roadways intended to alleviate traffic situations and daily commuting thereto;

WHEREAS, during the meeting conducted by the Committee on Metro Manila Development on 29 August 2018, the Committee found that many Metro Manila Representatives were totally unaware of several infrastructure projects in their districts, a number of which adversely affecting their constituents as well as some historical and significant structures within their representational jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, being the elected representatives of the people, the Metro Manila Congressmen have the duty to inform, explain, and monitor the progress and impact of these infrastructure projects in their respective districts to their constituents or become their voices when need be as they carry out checks and balances in government;


