RESOLUTION

URGING THE COMMITTEE ON BASIC EDUCATION OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO CONDUCT AN INVESTIGATION, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, INTO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE K-12 PROGRAM TO GAUGE ITS EFFECTIVENESS IN MODERNIZING PHILIPPINE EDUCATION

WHEREAS, a periodic review is a necessary exercise to gauge a comprehensive programs' effectiveness vis-à-vis its set out objectives;

WHEREAS, the Kindergarten to Grade 12 Program (K-12 Program) is a comprehensive program that sought to modernize and improve the Philippine basic education program to bring it to up to par with regional and international standards;

WHEREAS, the Department of Education, in implementing this ground-breaking program, has encountered institutional and systemic concerns and challenges that may have to be addressed by Executive and Legislative action if the proper assessment, monitoring, and evaluation benchmarks are identified or pinpointed;

WHEREAS, comparative analyses of the K-12 Program using regional and international standards and systems, particularly recent reforms implemented by the Singaporean educational system administrators can aid in further uplifting the country's quality of education;

WHEREAS, the multi-task study program is needed also to be examined vis-a-vis the absorptive capacity of higher education institutions to accommodate graduates of the K-12 Program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to urge the Committee on Basic Education of the House of Representatives to conduct an investigation, in aid of legislation, into the implementation of the K-12 Program to gauge its effectiveness in modernizing Philippine education.
