RESOLUTION

DIRECTING THE COMMITTEE ON HIGHER EDUCATION OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO CONDUCT AN INVESTIGATION IN AID OF LEGISLATION ON THE EXTENT OF RESEARCH AND EXTENSION FUNCTIONS OF STATE COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES (SUCS)

WHEREAS, the Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) are established to perform critical societal functions including but not limited to instruction, research and extension;

WHEREAS, annually, incremental allocations are made to enable State colleges and universities to undertake pioneering and development research that will significantly benefit their host localities;

WHEREAS, in the annual exercise of budget deliberations, quantitative and qualitative reports of research and extension services are often not extensively reported by State colleges and universities;

WHEREAS, along with these reports are definitive statuses of communities benefitting from or are impacted positively by the research and extension services of higher education institutions;

WHEREAS, while the University of the Philippines System has set the template for research and extension as exemplified by its recent collaboration with the Department Of Science and Technology (DOST) and a Japanese research outfit in developing a local satellite model and related prototypes, other state universities and colleges have yet to make public their similar efforts;

WHEREAS, in their statement of Vision, Mission and Goals, these higher education institutions have embraced host communities and the nation at large as recipients of their social development efforts.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to urge the Committee on Higher Education of the House of Representatives to conduct an investigation, in aid of legislation, on the extent of research and extension functions of State Colleges and Universities (SUCS).
