**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This bill proposes the conversion of the provincial road from Brgy. Mabini to Caridad Norte in Llanera, Nueva Ecija going to San Jose City, Nueva Ecija into a national road.

The provincial road is 14.1 Kilometers long and is an alternate route from Northern Luzon going to Central Luzon, from Cagayan or Pangasinan or from San Jose City via Llanera going to the cities of Palayan/ Cabanatuan, Gapan, Manila, and going back.

Unfortunately, the Provincial Government of Nueva Ecija lacks the necessary funds for the maintenance of the said provincial road. National funds can better cover the cost of improving and maintaining the road for better mobility of people, goods and services to and from Llanera, Nueva Ecija.

Support and approval for this proposed legislation are hereby earnestly sought.

**AN ACT CONVERTING THE BRGY. MABINI - CARIDAD NORTE ROAD IN LLANERA, NUEVA ECIIJA GOING TO SAN JOSE CITY, NUEVA ECIIJA INTO A NATIONAL ROAD**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

**SECTION 1.** The Brgy. Mabini - Caridad Norte Provincial Road in the Municipality of Llanera, Province of Nueva Ecija is hereby converted into a national road.

**SEC. 2.** The amount necessary for the implementation and maintenance of the said road shall be charged against the budget of the Department of Public Works and Highways under the current General Appropriations Act. Thereafter, such sum as may be necessary for its repair and maintenance shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

**SEC. 3.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
