

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill seeks to convert Holy Spirit Drive (formerly Inter-neighborhood Street) into a National Road. It links Commonwealth Avenue and Republic Avenue, two major thoroughfares in Quezon City vital to trade and commerce. Hence, the importance of the road sought to be included into the national road systems cannot be emphasized more.

The passage of this bill will ensure the allocation of annual funding for its repair and upkeep, affording the residents of Quezon City convenient, safe and more leisurely travel. Moreover, commerce and trade will flow unimpeded – allowing for unhampered progress.

For the above reasons, the immediate approval of this bill is most earnestly prayed.

AN ACT
CONVERTING HOLY SPIRIT DRIVE (FORMERLY INTER-NEIGHBORHOOD STREET) IN
QUEZON CITY INTO A NATIONAL ROAD

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Republic of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Holy Spirit Drive (formerly Inter-Neighborhood Street) in Quezon City is hereby converted into a National Road.

SEC. 2. The Secretary of the Department of Public Works and Highways shall include in the Department's program the improvement, maintenance and repair of the said road, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect thirty (30) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
