
EXPLANATORY NOTE

AN ACT

**GRANTING CASH REWARD TO RECIPIENTS OF ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AWARDS OR
LATIN HONORS IN COLLEGE**

*Be it enacted in the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Republic of the
Philippines in Congress assembled`*

SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the "Cash Reward for Academic
Excellence Awardees Act."

SEC 2. There shall hereby be granted cash reward to recipients of Academic
Excellence Award or Latin Honors on the occasion of their commencement exercises,
as follows:

<i>Summa Cum Laude:</i>	P30,000.00
<i>Magna Cum Laude:</i>	P20,000.00
<i>Cum Laude:</i>	P10,000.00

SEC. 3. The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act shall be
charged against the 2020 appropriations of the Commission on Higher Education.
Thereafter, such sums as may be necessary for the continuous implementation of this
Act shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
