CONVERTING THE CAMALIG BYPASS ROAD IN THE MUNICIPALITY
OF CAMALIG, PROVINCE OF ALBAY INTO A NATIONAL ROAD


EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill seeks to convert the Camalig Bypass Road, in Barangays Salugan, Quirangay, Sua and Tumpa, in the Municipality of Camalig, in the Province of Albay into a National Road.

The maintenance of the road is critical to the sustainable urbanization of the Municipality of Camalig, as it diverts traffic from Pan-Philippine Highway, helping ensure the unimpeded flow of goods and people around the población area of Camalig by allowing traffic to bypass the said area where heavy traffic was always observed especially at daytime.

Traffic is expected to further build up as the Bicol International Airport becomes operational by October 2021, and begins accepting international flights by May 2022. These diversion roads ensure that port, airport, and urban traffic do not coincide.

In view of the foregoing, the approval of this bill is urgently sought.

AN ACT
CONVERTING THE CAMALIG BYPASS ROAD IN THE MUNICIPALITY
OF CAMALIG, PROVINCE OF ALBAY INTO A NATIONAL ROAD

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The Camalig Bypass Road, in Barangays Salugan, Quirangay, Sua and Tumpa, in the Municipality of Camalig, in the Province of Albay, is hereby converted into a national road.

SEC. 2. The Secretary of Public Works and Highways shall include in the Department's program the improvement, repair and maintenance of the said road, the funding of which shall be included on the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its complete publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
