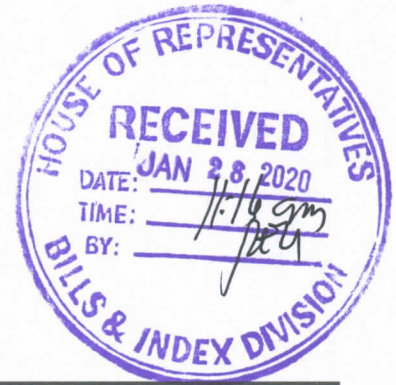

**RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE HOUSE COMMITTEE  
TO CONDUCT AN INVESTIGATION IN AID OF LEGISLATION ON THE CASES OF  
BURGLARIES OF VEHICLES AND/OR CARNAPPING INSIDE THE CAR-PARKS OF  
MALLS, OFFICE/COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS, OPEN PARKING SPACES, AND OTHER  
SIMILAR ESTABLISHMENTS**

**WHEREAS**, people customarily pay to park in places where they feel their vehicles and everything inside it are safe and secure;

**WHEREAS**, pay parking slots are available in the carpark of malls, office/commercial buildings, open parking spaces, and other similar establishments;

**WHEREAS**, burglaries of vehicles and/or carnappings have been happening in these establishments and the victims of these crimes have been, more often than not, left helpless by the operators/owners/managers of parking facilities;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to know and establish the obligations/liabilities, if any, of the operators/owners/managers of these parking facilities;

**RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, by the House of Representatives of the Republic of the Philippines, directing the appropriate House committee to conduct an investigation in aid of legislation on the cases of burglaries of vehicles and/or carnapping inside the car-parks of malls, office/commercial buildings, open parking spaces, and other similar establishments.
