3 RESOLUTION EXPRESSING PROFOUND SYMPATHY AND SINCEREST
4 CONDOLENCES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ON THE DEATH OF
5 PRESIDENT BENIGNO SIMEON COJUANGCO AQUINO III

8 WHEREAS, Benigno Simeon Cojuangco Aquino III, scion to one of
9 the most prominent pro-democracy political families in the Philippines,
10 was born on February 8, 1960;

11 WHEREAS, he first entered politics as congressional representative
12 of the 2nd District of Tarlac and served for three (3) consecutive terms in
13 the House of Representatives;

1 **WHEREAS**, he placed sixth in the May 2007 Senatorial elections
2 that earned him a seat in the Senate of the Philippines;

3 **WHEREAS**, he rose to become President of the Republic of the
4 Philippines from 2010-2016;

5 **WHEREAS**, President Aquino championed good governance
6 reforms, anti-corruption, and transparency under the mantra “Kayo ang
7 Boss Ko” and “Daang Matuwid”;

8 **WHEREAS**, during his six-year presidency, President Aquino
9 advocated flagship government programs such as the Pantawid
10 Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps), Bottom-up Budgeting Process, and
11 universal health care services that benefitted millions of Filipinos;

12 **WHEREAS**, President Aquino stood up as the face of the regional
13 confrontation with China over its claim involving West Philippine Sea;

14 **WHEREAS**, TIME Magazine named President Aquino as one of the
15 most influential people in the world in 2013 for steering the economy and
16 taking a stand on controversial issues in his country and the region;

17 **WHEREAS**, the 61-year old Aquino will be remembered for his
18 tireless campaign against corruption and poverty, akin to the legacy left
19 by his parents, enduring democracy icons Benigno Simeon Aquino Jr. and
20 Maria Corazon Cojuangco Aquino;


1 **WHEREAS**, Benigno Simeon Cojuangco Aquino III died last June

6 Cojuangco Aquino III.


7 **RESOLVED FURTHER** that a copy of this Resolution be furnished
