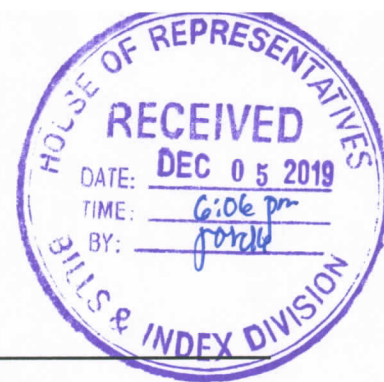

AN ACT

SEPARATING THE TABUK CITY NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL – BANTAY EXTENSION IN BARANGAY BANTAY, TABUK CITY, PROVINCE OF KALINGA FROM THE TABUK CITY NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, CONVERTING IT INTO AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS BANTAY NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. The Tabuk City National High School – Bantay Extension in Barangay
2 Bantay, Tabuk City, Province of Kalinga is hereby separated from the Tabuk City National
3 High School and converted into an independent national high school to be known as Bantay
4 National High School.

6 SEC. 2. All personnel, assets, liabilities and records of the Tabuk City National High
7 School - Bantay Extension are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Bantay National
8 High School.

10 SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in the Department's
11 program the operationalization of the Bantay National High School, the initial funding of
12 which shall be charged against the current year's appropriation of the Tabuk City National
13 High School – Bantay Extension. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued
14 operation of the school shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

16 SEC. 4. Within one hundred twenty (120) days after the approval of this Act, the
17 Secretary of Education shall formulate the rules and regulations implementing the provisions
18 of this Act.

20 SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official*
21 *Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
