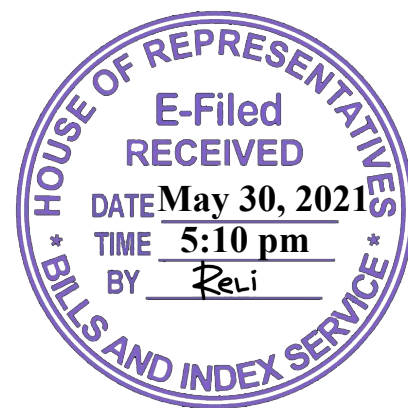

21 scheduled from January 25 to January 31, 2021 and from February 1 to 7, 2021 in Manacor,

23 **WHEREAS**, Eala, who was granted a full scholarship by the Rafael Nadal Academy,
24 was ranked number 2 in the junior rankings in 2020;

27 Her dedication at a very young age is worthy of emulation to many and the honor and
28 pride that she has given the country deserve our utmost commendation;
