AN ACT

SEPARATING THE MALINAO HIGH SCHOOL – PINAMULAAN ANNEX IN BARANGAY PINAMULAAN, MUNICIPALITY OF BANISILAN, PROVINCE OF COTABATO FROM THE MALINAO HIGH SCHOOL, CONVERTING IT INTO AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS PINAMULAAN NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. The Malinao High School – Pinamulaan Annex in Barangay
2 Pinamulaan, Municipality of Banisilan, Province of Cotabato is hereby separated from the
3 Malinao High School and converted into an independent national high school to be known as
4 Pinamulaan National High School.

5
6 SEC. 2. All personnel, assets, liabilities and records of the Malinao High School –
7 Pinamulaan Annex are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Pinamulaan National High
8 School.

10 SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in the Department’s
11 program the operationalization of the Pinamulaan National High School, the initial funding
12 of which shall be charged against the current year’s appropriation of the Malinao High School
13 – Pinamulaan Annex. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued operation of the
14 school shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

16 SEC. 4. Within sixty (60) days after the approval of this Act, the Secretary of
17 Education shall promulgate the rules and regulations implementing the provisions of this Act.

19 SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official*
20 *Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
