AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS
BARANGAY NEW LOWER BICUTAN IN THE CITY OF
TAGUIG, METROPOLITAN MANILA

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Creation of Barangay New Lower Bicutan.* – New
2 Lower Bicutan Proper in Barangay Lower Bicutan, City of Taguig,
3 Metropolitan Manila is hereby separated from Barangay Lower
4 Bicutan and constituted into a distinct and independent barangay
5 to be known as Barangay New Lower Bicutan.

6 SEC. 2. *Territorial Boundaries.* – The territorial boundaries
7 of Barangay New Lower Bicutan are hereby described as follows:

8 “Bounded on the Northeast by M.R.T. Avenue (formerly Pio
9 Felipe Street);

10 On the East and Southeast by Laguna de Bay;

11 On the South by Teodoro Santos Street, Taguig Bethel
12 Temple, Lots 350, 50 and 249 PLS 272; and

1 On the West and Northwest by Barrameda Street,
2 Maguindanao Street, Alfredo Cruz Street, Transmission Line, and
3 Barangay Signal Village Proclamation No. 172 Psd-13-002057.”

4 SEC. 3. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – The
5 plebiscite conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections
6 (COMELEC) in Barangay Lower Bicutan pursuant to City
7 Ordinance No. 69, Series of 2008 of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of
8 the City of Taguig, which ratified the creation of Barangay New
9 Lower Bicutan as proclaimed by the City Board of Canvassers on
10 December 28, 2008, shall serve as substantial compliance with the
11 plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160,
12 as amended, otherwise known as the “Local Government Code of
13 1991”.

14 SEC. 4. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.* – The incumbent
15 barangay officials of Barangay New Lower Bicutan, City of Taguig
16 shall continue to hold office until such time that their successors
17 have been duly elected and qualified.

18 SEC. 5. *Public Infrastructure and Facilities.* – All public
19 infrastructure and facilities existing therein at the time of the
20 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or
21 compensation to and shall be administered by the new barangay.

22 SEC. 6. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.* – Barangay New
23 Lower Bicutan shall be entitled to the Internal Revenue Allotment
24 (IRA) shares pursuant to Section 285 of the Local Government Code
25 of 1991, as amended.

26 SEC. 7. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15)
27 days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of
28 general circulation.
