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AN ACT DECLARING KAPANGYAN FALLS IN THE  
MUNICIPALITY OF BATARAZA, PROVINCE OF  
PALAWAN AN ECOTOURISM SITE, PROVIDING FOR  
ITS DEVELOPMENT AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS  
THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the  
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. The Kapangyan Falls in the Municipality of  
2 Bataraza, Province of Palawan is hereby declared an ecotourism  
3 site. As such, its development shall be prioritized by the  
4 Department of Tourism (DOT), subject to the rules and regulations  
5 governing the development of ecotourism sites.

6 SEC. 2. Within one (1) year from the approval of this Act, the  
7 DOT, in coordination with the municipal government of Bataraza  
8 and concerned agencies of the government, shall prepare a tourism  
9 development plan containing, among others, the construction,  
10 installation and maintenance of such appropriate facilities and  
11 infrastructure that shall encourage tourism in the area: *Provided,*

1 That said development plan shall ensure the preservation and  
2 conservation of the natural beauty and resources of the area.

3 SEC. 3. The DOT shall take immediate steps to implement  
4 the development plan in a manner that will protect and enhance the  
5 natural characteristics of Kapangyan Falls, and shall incorporate  
6 the same in its tourism development program for the ensuing  
7 calendar year. It shall also include Kapangyan Falls in all its  
8 national, regional and local promotion programs.

9 SEC. 4. The Secretary of the DOT shall include in the  
10 Department's program the implementation of this Act, the funding  
11 of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act  
12 and from internally generated funds of the DOT.

13 SEC. 5. Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act,  
14 the Secretary of the DOT shall promulgate the necessary rules and  
15 regulations for the proper implementation of this Act.

16 SEC. 6. All laws, rules, regulations, proclamations, executive  
17 orders or parts thereof inconsistent with this Act are hereby  
18 amended accordingly.

19 SEC. 7. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its  
20 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general  
21 circulation.
