AN ACT

UPGRADING THE NOVALICHES DISTRICT HOSPITAL IN BARANGAY BARTOLOME, QUEZON CITY, INTO A LEVEL II HOSPITAL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- **SECTION 1.** The Novaliches District Hospital in Barangay Bartolome, Quezon City is hereby upgraded into a Level II Hospital.
- **SEC. 2**. Any future increase in bed capacity shall be consistent with the hospital development plan that shall be prepared by the Chief of Hospital of the Novaliches District Hospital and submitted to the Department of Health (DOH).
- **SEC. 3.** The existing professional health care services and facilities of the Novaliches District Hospital shall also be upgraded to conform with and be commensurate to the increase in bed capacity as provided for in Section 2 hereof.
- **SEC. 4.** The existing workforce of the Novaliches District Hospital, which includes doctors, nurses, and support personnel, shall be increased correspondingly.
- **SEC. 5.** The local government of Quezon City shall provide the necessary funds to cover the maintenance and other operating expenses of the Novaliches District Hospital. It shall also appropriate funds for the additional human resource complement to support the increase in bed capacity and the corresponding upgrading of its service facilities and professional health care services.
- **SEC. 6.** The Secretary of the Department of Health (DOH) shall include in the Department's subsidy program its support for the capital outlay requirements of the hospital.
